### Suprobhat Paribahan must pay Tk 10 lakh to Abrar's family

SC upholds HC order STAFF CORRESPONDENT

The Supreme Court yesterday upheld a High Court order that directed Suprobhat Paribahan to pay Tk 10 lakh to the family of Abrar Ahmed Chowdhury, who was killed in a road crash on March 19.

A four-member bench of the Appellate Division headed by Chief Justice Syed Mahmud Hossain passed the order after dismissing a petition filed by Suprobhat Paribahan seeking stay on the HC order.

There is no merit in the stay petition of Suprobhat Paribahan, the apex court said in the order.

Writ petitioner Barrister Ruhul Quddus Kazal told The Daily Star that Suprobhat Paribahan must pay Tk 10 lakh to Abrar's family immediately, following the SC order.
