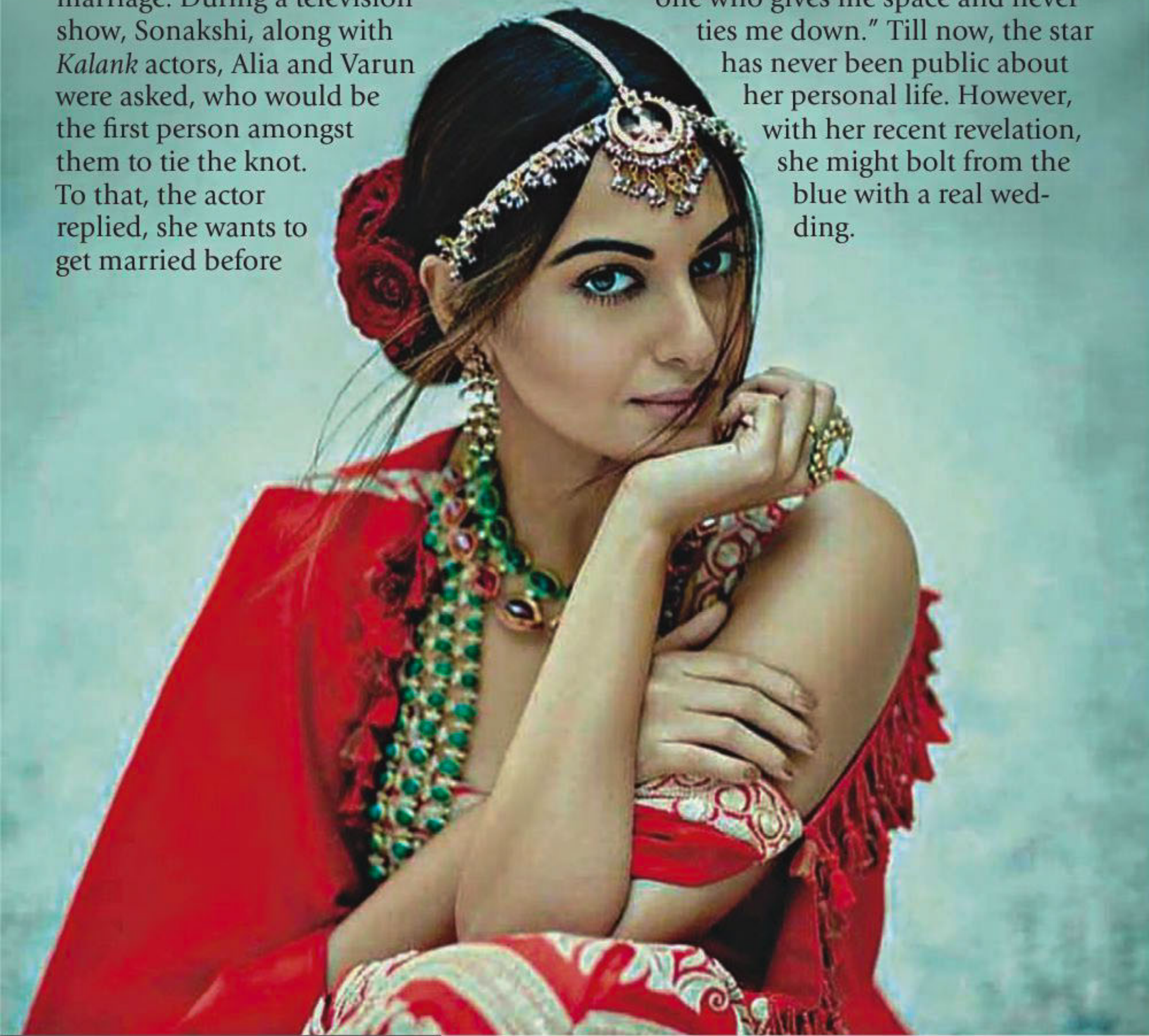


Bollywood wedding parody continues
