

Woman found dead in Mohammadpur

Police yesterday recovered the body of a woman from a tin-shed building in Dhaka's Mohammadpur area.

The identity of the woman, aged around 30, could not be known immediately, police said.

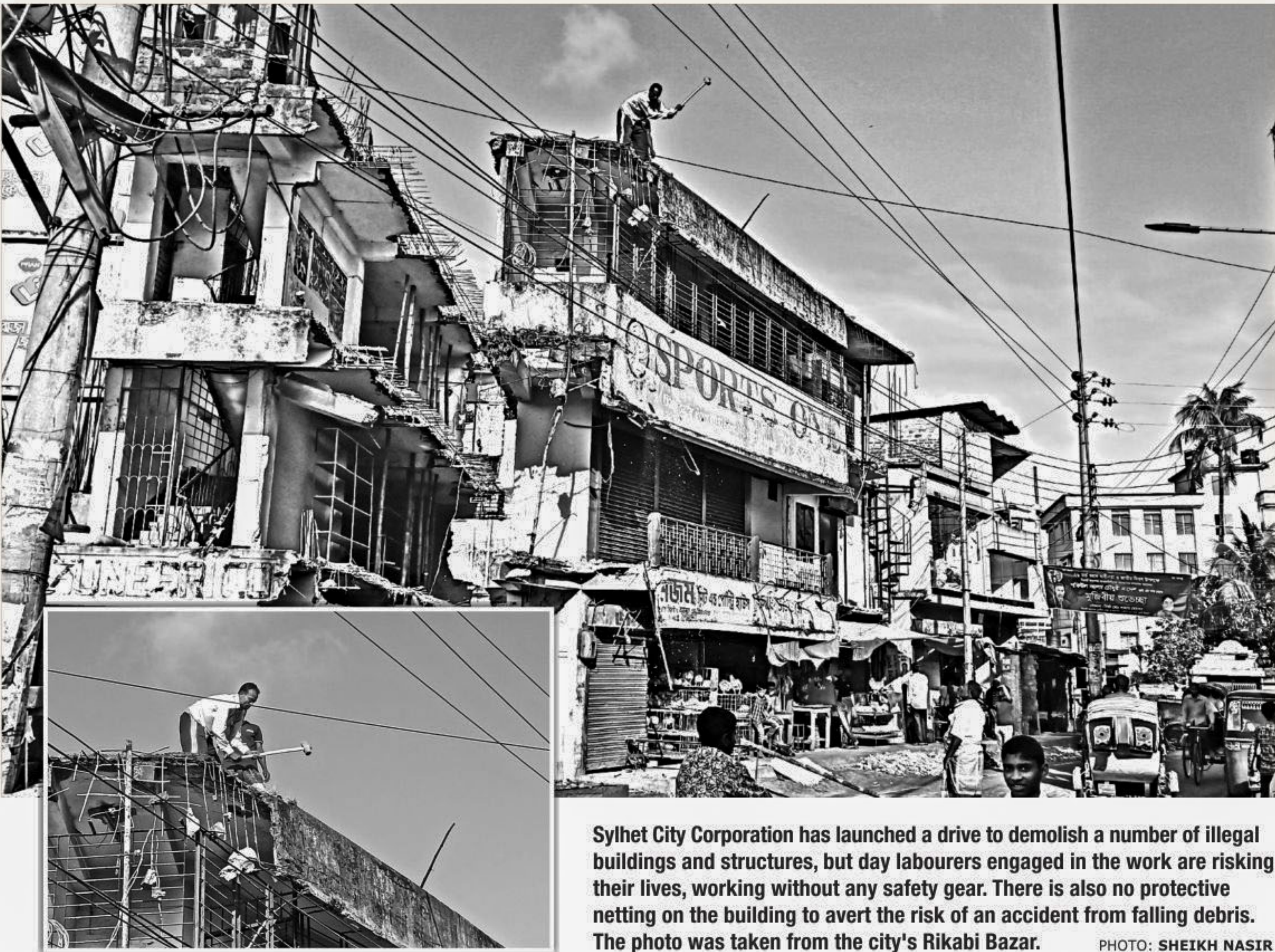
On information, police recovered the body in a pool of blood around 8:30am from inside the house in Chand Udyan area, said GG Biswas, officer-in-charge of Mohammadpur Police Station.

The woman had rented the makeshift house five days ago with a man. They claimed to be husband and wife, the OC said quoting the neighbours.

The "husband" went into hiding immediately after the incident, said the OC.

The body of the victim has been sent to Shaheed Suhrawardy Medical College morgue for autopsy, he added.

Meanwhile, morgue sources said the victim's tendons in both legs were severed and there were injury marks on her head.

Human chain for murdered trader

A human chain was held in front of the Narayanganj Press Club in Chashara yesterday, demanding justice for murdered garment trader Kamruzzaman Chowdhury Selim.

Rehana Akhter Rekha, wife of the deceased, said, "Three of my husband's killers have been arrested. They confessed how my husband was killed. Now if they go out, I promise that with my only child, I will take my own life at Chashara Shaheed Minar. I want justice for my husband."

Selim disappeared from his shop on March 31, according to a general diary filed by Rekha on April 6, and a kidnap case filed on April 8 with Fatullah Police Station. On April 10, Selim's body was recovered from under the ground in front of a warehouse in Bholail area. The same night, warehouse owner Mohammad Ali and two of his employees, Faisal and Yunus, were arrested. Faisal gave confessional statement to a Narayanganj court, admitting to killing Selim over embezzlement of Tk 2 lakh from warehouse owner Mohammad Ali.

researcher, while presenting the findings.

But allowing people to smoke at the restaurants reduce the overall number of customers, which the owners fail to understand, said Iqbal, head of the health sector at Ahsania Mission.

Syed Mahbubul Alam, a technical advisor of The Union, an international voluntary organisation, said when the tobacco control law was formulated in 2005, only a few restaurants followed it. But the situation has changed significantly in recent years. To keep up the progress, he suggested the government take strict measures against restaurants which "promote smoking" through setting up smoking zones.

He even had to climb up the pole as no ladder was available.

Visiting the workshop, this correspondent saw that the spot where Hafizur fell was covered with sand and there was no sign of accident.

FM Mohiuddin, divisional superintendent of the workshop, refuted the allegations. "It was an accident. We did not intend to spoil or hide evidence. We tried to clean the place so that the environment remains work-friendly," he said.

He claimed that they provided safety gears to the workers but they (workers) were reluctant to use those. "We will try to meet their demands after informing higher authorities."

This is not the first time the allegation of lack of safety measures at the workshop has surfaced.

On March 27, 13 workers fell sick after inhaling toxic gas when a fire broke out there. Fire service officials said the incident occurred due to an unsafe work environment.

Moreover, workers did not have any protective gear on while extinguishing the fire, they added.

Regarding yesterday's accident, Sheikh Md Nasir Uddin, officer-in-charge of Khulshi Police Station, said an unnatural death case was filed. He refused to comment on the allegation of tampering with evidence.

followers to return to the dormitories and not to get involved in any clashes.

After that, some followers of Ducusu AGS Saddam Hussain vandalised the room of BCL's Sir AF Rahman hall unit general secretary Mahmudul Hasan Tushar's room, alleged Tushar.

A BCL activist named Sagor Rahman was also allegedly beaten up.

Several BCL leaders, who were present at the spot last night, said carbonated drink Mojo is the main sponsor of the programme, and they had given a "certain amount" of money to the organisation. The conflict was ensued over sharing of the money.

Dhaka University Central Students' Union (Ducusu) general secretary Golam

Rabbani and assistant general secretary Saddam Hussain claimed that Ducusu and DU unit BCL jointly organised the two-day event, but Ducusu VP Nurul Haq Nur said he was not aware of the programme.

"Chhatra League men have usually been involved in such incidents on the campus. Chhatra League activists are involved this time too," Nur said about the incident.

Asked about the organiser of the concert, Nur said Ducusu has no involvement with the programme.

An official of Mojo, seeking anonymity, said they had contacted BCL leaders and Ducusu cultural affairs secretary, and did not contact the Ducusu VP as he is not a BCL activist.

Mojo, on the cover photo of its Facebook page, earlier wrote that DU Unit BCL was an associate of their programme, but on Friday night they uploaded a different cover page which said Ducusu and DU unit BCL are jointly organising the concert.

At 2:54am yesterday, Ducusu AGS Saddam Hussain wrote on Facebook that DU unit BCL and Ducusu are jointly organising the concert, but edited the post around 6pm yesterday, which said DU unit BCL organised the concert.

Chhatra League president Rezwatul Haque Chowdhury Shovon alleged that he was not notified of the programme, despite being the president of the organisation whereas the other three leaders claimed that Shovon was aware

of the event.

However, a number of posts shared by BCL men on social media mentioned that BCL in association with Ducusu organised the concert on the occasion of Pahela Baishakh -- to be observed today.

Contacted, Shovon said the programme was organised under the banner of BCL but he did not know anything about it despite being the president of the organisation.

"I do not know who set the fire. I did not give such instruction to anyone. I was hurt the way the three leaders are blaming me," said Shovon

Ducusu GS Golam Rabbani and AGS Saddam Hussain could not be reached over phone despite repeated attempts.

responsibility, said a press release of Green Voice, an environmentalist youth organisation.

"We don't want any promise; we want to see the culprits get maximum punishment," she said.

CPB President Mujahidul Islam Selim, who was protesting in front of Bangabhaban, said Nusrat's murder was a result of culture of injustice in the country.

Selim alleged that the ruling party was responsible for it too, as they carry out their criminal activities through their student affiliates. "The culprits know that they will not be punished if they use the power of the ruling party, and that is why these types of criminal activities are increasing day by day," he said.

Meherunnesa Rubi, 60, came with her daughter, daughter-in-law and granddaughter from Dhaka's Gendaria to join the protest. She said, "We all have come here to protest the killing of Rafi [Nusrat]. I have brought my little granddaughter, because little kids are not also safe from rape. We want their safety."

Another protester Shamima Akhter said, "We all should take to the streets and continue mass protests until exemplary punishment of culprits are ensured."


Sammilita Samajik Andolon and Oikya Nap demanded justice over other sensational cases, including that of Cumilla Victoria College student Sohagi Jahan Tonu.

They alleged that unwanted incidents are taking place in the country's madrasas one after another, because of administration's lack of accountability.

Dhaka University Teachers' Association, in a press statement yesterday, condemned the brutal murder and demanded exemplary punishment for the culprits immediately. The statement was issued by the Association's President Prof ASM Maksud Kamal and General Secretary Prof Shibli Rubayat Ul Islam.

Different organisations also formed human chains at Chapainawabganj and Patuakhali, report our correspondents.

Nusrat, 18, died at the hospital on Wednesday night, five days after she was set on fire on the roof of Sonagazi Senior Islamia Fazil Madrasa by suspected followers of principal SM Siraj-ud-Daula. They allegedly lured her to the roof, poured kerosene on her and set her on fire for refusing to lift sexual assault charges against the madrasa principal.
