## Six get death for killing govt officer in 2009

A Dhaka court yesterday sentenced six persons to death for the murder of Aminul Haque alias Anis Khadem, an administrative officer of Dhaka Divisional Commissioner's Office, in May 2009.

The convicts are: Shahidur Rahman Khadem, Mahbub Alam Liton, Sheikh Shamim Ahmed, Md Jewel, Kamal Hossain Biplob and Sohel. Two other accused are: Abdullah Md

Nazim Uddin Babu and Ajgor Hossain Rana. Babu was given life in jail while Rana was acquitted as the charge brought against him could not be proved.

Liton, Biplob and Babu are absconding while five others were present at the court yesterday.

The punishment of the fugitives will be effective from the day of their arrest or surrender and the convicts can file appeals with the High Court within 30 days from the receipt of the judgement copy.

Judge Abdur Rahman Sardar of Speedy Trial Tribunal-4 of Dhaka handed down the sentence in presence of five of the accused at a packed courtroom.

Earlier, the prosecution and the defence had completed their arguments and the tribunal recorded statements of 17 prosecution witnesses including complainant of the case.

Aminul was shot to death near Dhaka's Malibagh Shahi Masjid on May 4, 2009.

The government officer had been serving as the general secretary of Kharampur Mazar Committee (shrine committee) in Brahmanbaria's Akhaura.

According to the case, Shahidur Rahman ordered the killing of Aminul following a spat over the ownership of properties in the shrine.

Aminul's son Saidul Haque Khadem filed a murder case with Motijheel Police Station the day after he was killed.

During the investigation, all eight accused confessed to the killing to magistrates on different dates.

On December 30 of 2009, Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) pressed charges against the eight accused and the tribunal framed charges against them on June 8, 2014.

Palliative Care

## Experts emphasise raising awareness

Life might be cut short by an incurable disease but a better understanding of how to make the journey meaningful with love and care can help ease the sufferings of the patients. This is what is known as palliative care. It can help a child with terminal cancer and their parents deal with the medical and psychological aspects better. Such facilities are rare in the country and whatever

services available now are Dhaka-centric, while as many

as 12,000 children are being diagnosed with cancer every

year. One in four children with cancer does not survive five years after the diagnosis. Palliative care can improve quality of their end-of life experiences and support families even after patients death, said medical experts, social workers and parents yesterday at a seminar and workshop organised by

Hospice Bangladesh, with support from Aastha Hospice and World Child Cancer, in the capital's Gulshan. All healthcare facilities combined -- private and public -- have only 18 beds for palliative care of paediatric cancer patients. "It is far from what's necessary," said Prof Zohora Jameela Khan, of paediatric hematology and oncology department at Dhaka Medical College

Hospital. Palliative care is often termed "low-tech and hightouch", she said.

The care focuses on healing rather than curing. The caregivers -- through conversations, counselling and listening -- help patients and their families accept death and prepare for it, said Shahinur Kabir, founder director and palliative physician of Hospice Bangladesh.

Recollecting her experience with a patient named Pavel, Bangladesh NGOs Network for Radio | Zohora said his parents were willing to understand what their son needed while undergoing treatment at ASHIC

Foundation's palliative care unit in Dhanmondi. Pavel knew, like many children with cancer, that his days were numbered. His wish to have a family trip to Cox's Bazar was fulfilled with help from ASHIC, a charity working to support children with cancer and their parents. Rohingya
