Bodies toil away in the final stages of their hard work which involves a lot of threshing, cleaning, reaping, field drying, stacking and bagging. Despite the sudden rains and hail storms, farmers are hopeful that they will have good yield this season. While the yield isn't the problem, the prices being offered by wholesalers are. Some farmers complained that they were being offered Tk 520-580 per maund instead of the government set price of Tk 1050 per maund. They said this stemmed from a lack of monitoring in the crop fields, where a lot of the buying and selling takes place.
