Firozi and Chu Zhuquan of the joint venture company signed the contract on behalf their respective sides. Firozi said efficient and reliable transport system is the lifeline of any densely populated city like Dhaka. "The rapid population growth of Dhaka city warrants a better, comfortable and reliable public transport system. Circular rail can meet this demand in a better and efficient manner," he said. Mofazzel Hossain, secretary to railways ministry, said the circular rail line will be constructed in alignment with the existing Inner Ring Road of the city. He urged the contractor to hold talks with other stakeholders like Roads and Highways Department and shipping ministry so that they support it and do not raise issues during implementation of the project. Railways Minister Nurul Islam Sujon said the project is part of the government's mega plan for the railway sector. Bangladesh Railway Director General Qazi Md Rafiqul Alam also spoke the programme.

In response, Refugee Relief and Repatriation Commissioner (RRRC) Abul Kalam Azad said 3,00,000 Rohingya children are now going to informal schools up to class two. The government has approved their education for class three as well. A good number of Rohingya men and women are also employed in temporary jobs in the camps, and many are getting training. Some are also informally engaged in fishing and farming outside the camps, Abul Kalam said. Host communities are also being affected due to wage competition and rising prices of essentials, he said. Engaging Rohingya in productive jobs requires huge investments, he added. Turning to Rohingya relocation to Bhashanchar island in Noakhali, where government has built planned accommodation, he said there is no risk of landslide in Bhashanchar, but such risks are high in Cox's Bazar during monsoon. Bhashanchar also offers more options of livelihood, he said. However, it is not going to be forced relocation.

President Rashed Khan Menon said different online social communication platforms should be brought under strict vigilance to stop rumours. Former Dhaka University Vice Chancellor AAMS Arefin Siddique said people around the globe should try to establish a peaceful world based on humanism. "Otherwise, it will not be possible to stop militant attacks like those in New Zealand and Sri Lanka." Sammilita Sangskritik Jote President Golam Kuddus said the evil forces that opposed the country's independence are trying to regroup under different names, after losing their reputation before the nation due to war crimes. Mohammad Nasim, 14-party alliance coordinator and chair of the programme, said the incumbent government has been victorious against militancy in the past, and the battle will continue. He welcomed the parliament members of BNP for taking oath. "I thank our BNP friends for joining the parliament. They should come forward to resist militancy with us, to rectify the mistakes of the past," said Nasim, also an AL presidium member. Among others, Awami League Presidium Member Matia Chowdhury, Bangladesher Samyabadi Dal General Secretary Dilip Barua, Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) President Rezwanul Huq Chowdhury Shovon, Bangladesh Film Development Corporation (BFDC) Managing Director Pijush Bandyopadhyay, Deputy Speaker of the parliament Md Fazle Rabbi Miah and Bangladesh Sarak Paribahan Shramik Federation President Shahjahan Khan also spoke at the rally.

also said that climate change will affect sustainable development goals related to food security, poverty, education, gender equality, environmental sustainability and development. "Bangladesh has done enough in preparing the right strategies, but we lack resources. We lack resources because the international community has not lived up to its promise of providing resources," he said. Referring to areas of the country affected by salinisation, Dr Saleemul Huq, director of International Centre for Climate Change and Development, suggested investing in children of farmers of those areas. "If we don't invest in them, they will all migrate to Dhaka which is already overburdened. We will train them, so that they can be incentivised to live in other towns," he said. Reiterating that developed countries are responsible for climate change, Dr Huq suggested applying the same formula internationally. "It's a global responsibility. We can engage them by saying 'You're causing displacement of our people, so you need to take some of them'." To attract developed countries to recruit people from the country willingly, he suggested grooming the youth as qualified professionals. Atiq Rahman, executive director of Bangladesh Centre for Advanced Studies, said sea level rise and formation of islands are happening simultaneously in the country. But the rise is happening so fast that it will ultimately beat the island formation, and submerge those. Intiaz A Hussain, a professor of Independent University, Bangladesh, said the nation has not seen war since 1971, but war may come our way 50 years from now because of climate change. The Daily Star Editor and Publisher Mahfuz Anam and Associate Editor Brig Gen (ret) Shahedul Anam Khan, IUCN Bangladesh Country Representative Raquibul Amin and Prothom Alo Consulting Editor Ayesha Kabir also spoke at the discussion.

4 arrested over RMG worker's gang-rape

Police yesterday arrested four persons in connection with a case filed over allegedly raping a ready-made garment worker in Kathgora area of Savar on Monday night. The arrestees are Nur Mohammad Polash, Md Sujon Shikder, Md Ferdosh and Kabir Hossen, said Javed Masud, inspector (investigation) of Ashulia Police Station, adding that another accused Abdur Razzak is on the run. Quoting the girl, police said, around 8:30pm on Monday, the 22-year-old RMG worker was going to Kathgora area with her husband. When they reached a bamboo grove in the area, the five accused stopped them. They tied up her husband and then dragged the girl inside the bamboo grove. Later, four accused allegedly gang-raped her while Razzak helped in the crime. The girl reported the incident to the police, and on information, police conducted several drives arresting the four accused. The girl was sent to One Stop Crisis Centre of DMCH, said the Inspector.

and other institutions also participated. "It is true that Islam has been targeted after the 9/11 incident; [hence] Islamophobia has also increased," Prof Fakrul Alam said. On the research findings, he said, "The paper represented the binary aspect of religion versus secularism. But secularism should be discussed in light of multiple aspects [culture, society, economic state etc]." "We had adopted secularism in our constitution in 1972 and there was no conflict with religion," he added. "It was once believed that secularism will solve all problems. But [now it has been proven] that is not easy. So all thinking should be multidimensional," said Prof Fakrul Alam.
