## Septic tank gas kills two labourers

Two labourers died after inhaling toxic gas trapped inside a septic tank in Kaharol upazila of the district yesterday.

The deceased, Abdul Khaleque, 45, son of Jahurul Islam, and Naser Ali, 25, son of Azizul Islam, were residents of Bhinaikuri village in Biral upazila of the district.

Quoting locals, Officer in Charge (OC) of Kaharol Police Station Ayub Ali said the duo went to the house of Shamsher Ali in Ishai Chowdhurypara area for the maintenance work of a septic tank around

8:00am yesterday.

Khaleque first entered the septic tank and fell unconscious inside it, the OC said, adding that later Naser entered the tank to rescue Khaleque, but he also fainted after inhaling the toxic gas trapped inside it.

Though local people with the help of fire fighters managed to pull them out, but found them dead.

Being informed, police recovered the bodies and sent those to M Abdur Rahim Medical College Hospital for autopsy, the OC added.

## NUSRAT MURDER PBI recovers glass used to pour kerosene

### Three accused placed on one day's fresh remand

The glass that was used to pour kerosene on Sonagazi madrasa student Nusrat Jahan Rafi was recovered yesterday evening in Sonagazi of Feni by Police Bureau of Investigation (PIB).

The glass was recovered from a wall cabinet inside Sonagazi Islamia Madrasa principal's office located on the first floor of the institution's administrative building, said Mohammad Moniruzzaman, additional superintendent of PIB in Feni.

A team of PIB took along the case's three accused -- Shahadat Hossain Shamim, Javed Hossain alias Sakhat and Saifur Rahman Md Jobair -- to the madrasa and recovered the glass, based on their statements, he added.

Earlier, Senior Judicial Magistrate Md Zakir Hossain placed each of the three accused on one day's remand against a prayer for two days' remand for each, said Shah Alam, an inspector of PBI and investigation officer of the case.

The fresh remands for the trio were sought for recovery of further evidence and for further interrogation, he also said.

According to the court, in a declaration made before her death, Nusrat said before her attackers set fire to her, they had used a glass to pour kerosene on her.

Until yesterday, the glass, a crucial evidence in the crime, could not be recovered.

The three accused in remand and two girls, all wearing burqa, set Nusrat on fire after tying her hands and legs with rope.

On April 6, Nusrat Jahan Rafi, a student of Sonagazi Islamia Senior Fazil Madrasa, was set on fire, allegedly for refusing to withdraw a case she had filed against her madrasa principal for sexually harassing her in late March.

She lost her battle for life on April 10, five days after she was set afire -- an incident that sparked outrage in the country.

So far, a total of 21 people have been arrested for their alleged involvement in Nusrat Jahan Rafi's murder and 18 of the arrestees have been placed on different terms of remand.

## Journalist tortured 'for reporting attempted rape'

Criminals beat a journalist of a local Bangla daily on Tuesday allegedly for reporting an attempt to rape incident in Sunamganj's Shalla upazila a few months ago.

Critically injured Jayanta Sen, 45, a resident of Anandapur village and Sallah upazila correspondent of The Daily Sunamkantha, is now undergoing treatment at Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital with fractured right leg.

While talking to this correspondent, Jayanta said one Gopal Roy, of the village, and his men waylaid him near Jaypur area while he was going to the district headquarters on a rickshaw on Tuesday night.

They later beat him up mercilessly with bamboo sticks and snatched away Tk 20,000, a laptop and two mobile phone sets from him, leaving him critically injured, he said.

Locals rescued him and admitted him to Sunamganj Sadar Hospital from where he was later shifted to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital for better treatment.

Locals said a feud developed between the two after Joyanta, also upazila unit general secretary of Haor Bachao Sunamganj Bachao, a platform for ensuring farmers' rights, published a report on Gopal, when the latter tried to rape a farmer's daughter, also a Class VIII student, a few months ago.

Officer in Charge (OC) of Shalla Police Station Ashrafur Islam said Joyanta phoned him on Tuesday noon and told him that Gopal was threatening him continuously.

They will take necessary steps in this regard soon, the OC said.

## False murder victim found in M'singh

His mother in a case claimed that he 'went missing' as his 'uncles killed him' eight months ago

Police on Tuesday morning detained a teenager whose mother in a false case, filed with a Pabna court eight months ago, claimed that his uncles had murdered him and concealed his body.

After tracking down the boy in a restaurant in Mymensingh city, police in the afternoon produced him before the Pabna Judicial Magistrate's Court, which handed him over to the custody of his family, said Obaidul Haque, officer-in-charge (OC) of Pabna Sadar Police Station.

Before being released, the boy in a confessional statement before the court stated that his mother, Pabna Sadar upazila resident Merina Khatun, filed the case in September last year to harass his uncles over property dispute.

Ever since, he had been away from home and staying in different parts of the country, The OC quoted the boy as saying.

In the case statement, Merina Khatun claimed that her son could not be traced as her three brothers-in-law killed him and were hiding his body since September 10.

Police started investigation according to court order and during investigation, police found out that the victim, as claimed in the case, was in fact alive, OC Obaidul said.

Investigators then focused on finding the false victim. And eight months after filing of the case, through the use of tracking technology, they succeeded in catching up with him on Tuesday morning at a restaurant in Mymensingh district headquarters.

Police will now file their final report, mentioning Merina Khatun and her son's false claim and ill motive in filing the case in September, 2018, he said, adding that they would file another case against the woman and her son for filing a case with false murder claim.

2,000 hydraulic horns seized from auto-rickshaws

Traffic police in an offensive against noise pollution confiscated around two thousand hydraulic horns from auto-rickshaws in Brahmanbaria town yesterday.

Sarwar Hossain, traffic inspector of police in Brahmanbaria Sadar, said they have started the drive to free the district town from noise pollution.

They would continue the drives until hydraulic horns are removed from all types of vehicles, he added.

They are currently conducting inspections on auto-rickshaws at four locations -- Kawtuli Bus stand, Fakirapool, Court road and Kumarshil intersection, of the town and eventually they will remove the noise polluting horns from all sorts of vehicles including battery-run three wheelers and motorcycles, he said.
