

Speeding truck crashes into roadside market

Damages seven shops in Lalmonirhat; driver was apparently sleeping

A stone-laden truck travelling from Borguna to Burimari land port crashed into a market in Lalmonirhat early yesterday, wrecking seven shops, according to our correspondent.

The incident happened around 4:30am at Milon Bazar of Hatibandha upazila, when the vehicle skidded off Lalmonirhat-Burimari highway as the driver lost control over the steering, said police.

Truck driver Mizanur Rahman was apparently asleep on the steering wheel, Hatibandha Police Station Officer-in-Charge Omar Farooque quoted locals as saying.

Locals rushed the trucker to Rangpur Medical College Hospital in critical condition.

However, no casualty was reported at the shops as the employees went to have sehri at that time, said the OC.

The damaged shops include three grocery stores, two of electronics, one cosmetics and another of cellphones, according to traders.

The shop owners expressed their helplessness at the loss caused by the accident. One Jahangir Alam said, "All the commodities worth about Tk 4 lakh were damaged as the truck entered my shop. I don't know how will I recoup the loss during the month of Ramadan?"

Another trader, Krishna Chandra Roy, said, "My shop and all the electronics goods kept in it were damaged."

He estimated the loss caused by the crash at

Tk 5 lakh.

Similar statements came from other traders -- Ziarul Islam, Abu Taleb, Abu Sayeed, Sagir Hossain and Fazal Miah.

OC Omar Farooque said, "We are verifying valid documents of the truck and its driver." The truck owner was informed of the accident, he said.

"The truck will not be handed over to its owner unless compensation is paid to the affected persons," the police officer assured.

Meanwhile, a truck hit a worker from behind at NCIT gate at Chittagong Port yesterday, killing him on the spot, our staff correspondent from Chattogram adds.

The deceased, Ali Asgar, was from Bhola Sadar, said Mohammad Bodrudduza, sub-inspector of Bandar Police Station.

Director Mahbulul Alam interrogated them at the DGHS office in the capital's Mohakhali.

ACC also served a notice to clerk Khairul Alam, but he was not present at the office yesterday.

The anti-graft team also collected relevant information and documents of furniture purchase for the medical college in 2016-17 fiscal.

In December 2017, principal of the medical college sought allocation of about Tk 20.85 crore for buying furniture, ACC

sources said.

The DGHS officials approved the proposal.

Two construction firms got the tender for procurement, and one of them was paid Tk 3.49cr, ACC officials added.

"There was no allocation for furniture in the budget, still the DG and other officials recommended for the allocation. It is clear that corruption has taken place," Mahbulul said.

Talking to journalists, DG Azad denied the allegations, and said ACC sought his cooperation and he is abiding by it.

Man 'pushed off bus' to death

A man was killed on the airport road in Dhaka, as a driver's helper allegedly pushed him from a moving bus on Saturday evening.

The victim, 24-year-old Md Harun, is a painter who lived in Atibazar area of Keranigaj. He got married six months ago, said police.

Quoting witnesses on the road, Banani Police Station's Sub-Inspector Rajibul Hasan said Harun took a bus of Kheyra Paribahan from Mohakhali to his in-law's house in Sherpur. As the sun set, he wanted to stop for taking iftar.

But the bus didn't stop, and the helper pushed him off the vehicle, said the SI, adding that they seized the bus from Khilkhet area and arrested driver Bahadur Ali, 44. His helper Alam is on the run.

Police produced him before a Dhaka court yesterday with a five-day remand prayer. The court granted police one-day remand, said SI Rajibul.

Barishal rights activists demand PM's intervention

Rights activists yesterday staged a demonstration in Barishal city, demanding speedy trial and capital punishment for rapists and killers of Shahinoor Akter Tania.

They formed a human chain in front of the city's Ashwini Kumar Hall and brought out a procession, seeking prime minister's intervention in the matter.

They also submitted a memorandum to the PM through the deputy commissioner and divisional commissioner.

Sammilita Nari o Shishu Nirjatan Proirodh Andolon, Barishal organised the programmes where more than 50 human and women's rights activists and representatives from various organisations -- including Swadhinata Nurses Parishad and Integrated Social Development Association -- participated.

NHRC condemns death threats to 3 noted citizens

National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) yesterday condemned recent death threats to prominent personalities -- Sultana Kamal, Shahriar Kabir and Prof Muntassir Mamoon, terming it an "act of cowardice" in a press release.

NHRC Chairman Kazi Reazul Hoque said threatening human rights activists of their stature is equivalent to threatening development and human rights itself.

Urging the authorities to take the matter seriously, he asked the government to ensure adequate security for them and bring the perpetrators to justice as soon as possible.

According to Sultana and Mamoon, a militant group published a magazine "Lone Wolf" in March this year, where it narrated preparations to kill the three prominent individuals.

Seeking security, Sultana and Mamoon filed CDs with Dhanmondi Police Station on March 4 and 6 respectively.

transporting drinking water," said Khairul Islam, Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Barishal City Corporation (BCC).

"Department of Public Health Engineering has not yet handed over two surface water treatment plants in Beltola and Rupatali to BCC, as there are still some technical faults they are working out. Once there is regular supply from these plants, we will get 3.2 crore litres of water," said Humayun Kabir, executive engineer of BCC.

There is a demand for 5.6 crore litres of water in the area but BCC can supply only 2.9 crore litres, he added.
