In protest of the incident, the hospital interns observed a daylong strike on Saturday and formed a human chain the next day. On Monday night, the hospital director, Dr Ferdous Hasan, filed a case with Kotwali Police Station, accusing Sarwar and 8-10 unknown people of threatening to kill and rape the female doctor.

Asked about Sarwar's release yesterday, Officer-in-Charge of Kotwali Police Station Selim Miah said, "We had arrested the BCL leader but we let him go as he took advance bail from Sylhet chief metropolitan magistrate's court."

and reservoir for dousing fire. He said they need to renovate electrical lines to reduce fire risk, adding that they are taking initiatives to this end.

Mohammad Firoz, office secretary of New Market Samity, said apart from 70 fire extinguishers installed by them, they have trained 13 security guards. He also claimed that they conducted fire drills in the market.

Manzur Ahmed, president of Chandrima Super Market Dokan Malik Samity, claimed that they have set up 40 fire extinguishers in the market, and asked all shop owners to set up fire extinguishers individually.

There is an acute scarcity of water in and around the market as there is no waterbody in the vicinity, nor are there any water reservoirs, he said.

Wasa should take steps to set up fire hydrants in important points of the city, especially where markets are situated, to help firefighters douse fire quickly, he added.

Boy killed 'by teenagers'

A teenage boy was stabbed dead, allegedly by several teenagers, in Cumilla city on Monday night.

Azmain Adil, 16, passed SSC examination this year, said his father Abdus Sattar.

Adil's schoolmates said he was riding a motorbike in Mogoltuli area when he hit another teenager. Four to five juveniles ganged up and attacked Adil with sharp weapons, leaving him injured. Locals took him to Cumilla Medical College Hospital where doctors declared him dead.

No case was filed till filing of this report, said Kotwali Model Police Station OC Abu Salam Mia.

Rickshaw-puller stabbed to death

Unidentified criminals stabbed a rickshaw-puller to death in Chattogram yesterday.

Locals found Md Raju, 28, lying in Haji Para area with stab marks on his abdomen, said police.

He was rushed to Chattogram Medical College Hospital (CMCH) where doctors declared him dead, said Jahir Uddin, in-charge of CMCH police outpost.

No further details could be known about him.

Sadip Kumar Das, OC of Double Mooring Police Station, said they were investigating the matter.

He said the tests would check whether the declared ingredients of drugs are alright, if there is any component of "harmful pyrogen" that may cause fever, and identify any other element that caused the reactions.

He said he talked to some of the patients who suffered drug reactions and their attendants, and would send their statements to the laboratory authorities.

Some 14 paediatric patients, aged between two and eight, experienced high fever and convulsions following intravenous infusions of some drugs at the hospital on Saturday night.

The next day, the hospital authorities stopped using four drugs -- two antibiotics, an antacid and an antispasmodic -- on the children.

That night, similar drug reactions occurred among four orthopaedic patients, forcing the authorities to stop using the drugs on all patients.

A three-member committee was formed on Sunday, led by medicine department professor Mohammad Hasan Tarik, to investigate into the incident.

The committee was asked to report within three days.

During a visit to the hospital yesterday, this correspondent saw out of 14 children, 11 were released while out of four orthopaedic patients, three were released.

Md Badiuzzman, father of a four-year old boy, said his son was brought to the hospital with swollen face and fever on

May 1, and he was improving since being admitted.

On Saturday night when he was given the injections, he started shivering with increased body temperature. "The shivering stopped within hours, but a new phenomenon arose that his urine has become yellowish," the father said, adding that his son's health is regressing again.

The DGDA assistant director said he also talked to mothers of two child patients.

They told him that one of the children was given an antibiotic injection while the other was given antacid injection between 10pm and 10:30pm on Saturday night, and minutes after that they began shivering with fever.

The senior doctors treated them, provided some of them with artificial oxygen and they got well in two to three hours, he said.

At the orthopaedic ward, one Abdullah, 20, of Natore's Doyarampur area was admitted with a broken right hand on May 9 night. He suffered drug reactions on Sunday night after he was given the same antibiotic injections.

"Minutes after the nurse went away administering the injections, it felt like my brain was boiling. My jaws clenched and I began convulsing on the bed. It became difficult for my mother alone to hold me down," Abdullah said.

Doctors treated him in the next two hours, he said.

told The Daily Star that ACC filed the case with Ramna Police Station on October 9, 2014 against Annie on charges of amassing illegal wealth worth Tk 1.4 crore and concealing information about his wealth worth Tk 13.14 lakh.

A special judge court of Dhaka framed charges against Annie in the case on May 24, 2016.

Following the same revision petition,

the HC on September 1, 2016 stayed trial proceedings of the case and issued a rule asking ACC and the government to show causes why Annie should not be exonerated from the charges, DAG Manik added.

After holding hearing, HC yesterday rejected the revision petition, he added.

Advocate Zainul Abedin appeared for Annie at the hearing, while Advocate Khurshid Alam Khan represented the anti-graft body.

Rape of 7th Grader

Madrasa teacher held in Ctg

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) arrested a madrasa teacher yesterday for allegedly raping a minor at Banshkhali of Chattogram.

The arrestee Md Foyjullah, 20, was a teacher of Pashchim Chambul Azizia Kashemul Ulum Balok-Balika Madrasa, said Maj Mahadi Hasan of Rab-7.

He allegedly raped a seventh-grade student inside a classroom, with the excuse of giving private tuition on April 24.

As she did not return home on time,

guardians of the victim went to the madrasa and found the girl crying alone.

She told her guardians of the incident, who then complained to madrasa authorities. The authorities assured the family of taking steps, while Foyjullah fled the madrasa, said Rab officials.

The victim was taken to CMCH; a medical report confirmed the rape.

The family then filed a case with Banshkhali Police Station on May 1. Rab officials arrested Foyjullah at 4:10am from his residence, said Maj Mahadi.

While selling vegetables in Uttara area, Nurjahan used to collect phone number of her customers. Jakir also used to collect numbers from different sources like cellphone balance recharge points.

Then they provided the numbers to Sraboni, and she gave missed calls to the targeted numbers. Whoever responded, Sraboni talked to them with the aim of developing a relationship.

Later, Sraboni would take the victim to a temporarily rented house. Other members of the group would barge in, catch the two

during a private moment, take pictures and threaten to disclose their "illicit relation". They would then force the victim to pay at least 140,000-50,000 through mobile transactions, DB claimed, quoting the arrestees.

DB ADC Sahadat said that sometimes the syndicate members pretended to be police officials or journalists to intimidate the victims.

Such incidents went unreported as victims usually avoid filling complaints with police fearing a tarnished reputation, he added. "We are now trying to get details of other victims."

Canadian University arranges discussion

Founder and Chairman of Canadian University of Bangladesh Dr Chowdhury Nafeez Sarafat recently organised a meeting between high level diplomats, eminent businessmen and key stakeholders focusing on Student Partnership Program (SPP) between Bangladesh and Canada, said a press release.


The meeting was held recently in Toronto, Canada. High Commissioner of Canada to Bangladesh Benoit Préfontaine and High Commissioner of Bangladesh to Canada Mizanur Rahman graced the event as chief guest and guest of honor, respectively.

SPP is an arrangement that provides quick and easy visa processing for studying in Canada. Canadian High Commission had previously entered into SPP arrangements with India and China which facilitated thousands of students from the two countries.

A large number of Bangladeshi students apply for studying in Canada each year but a significant number of these applications get declined as students are unable to meet eligibility criteria.

Once implemented, the proposed SPP in Bangladesh will result in faster visa processing, less documentation and streamlined admission and visa guidelines for all SPP participating institutions.
