The weekly market operates within a short window of three hours, from 3:00am to 6:00am. All the people involved in the trade, production and sales of Jamdani attend the bazaar. While Jamdani's history is intertwined with that of the country, its speciality lies in its manufacturing, as the fabric has intricate designs that can take weavers days or even months to perfect.


