

ACC to seek Ruhul Amin Hawlader's wealth statement

Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) is going to ask former Jatiya Party secretary general ABM Ruhul Amin Hawlader to submit his wealth statement next week.

ACC Public Relations Officer Pranab Kumar Bhattacharjee said a notice will be issued to this effect.

ACC had already summoned Hawlader asking him to appear before it on May 14 to face interrogation over his alleged accumulation of a huge amount of illegal wealth.

He, however, skipped that date, writing to the ACC that he could not attend because of performing umrah.

Hawlader also skipped the interrogation of ACC on May 4 as the High Court stayed its notice.

On April 16, 2014, ACC initiated an inquiry into alleged illegal wealth accumulation by Ruhul Amin Hawlader.

Fire at Ctg EPZ factory

A fire gutted valuables at a factory in Chattogram Export Processing Zone yesterday evening.

The fire originated on the top floor of five-storey Unity Accessories Limited on road-1 around 7:33pm, said Jashim Uddin, assistant director of Fire Service and Civil Defence.

Some 14 vehicles of four units of firefighters rushed to the spot while Bangladesh Navy also joined the efforts, and brought it under control after around an hour.

There was no report of casualties until filing of the report at 9:20pm. As the factory manufactured cartons and cotton, it would take time to extinguish the fire completely, said Farid Ahmed Chowdhury, deputy assistant director of fire service.

"There are chemical containers on the floor and the temperature is still high. The risk has not been eliminated completely yet," said Farid.

their arrest or surrender, and the convicts can appeal to High Court within 30 days, said the judge.

The victim, Monir, was a resident of Munshihati village under Kamrangirchar Police Station. On April 17, 2013, he was abducted and later killed by the convicts including his estranged wife Kakoli. The convicts cut the victim's body into pieces, and dumped them in different areas.

Later on April 28, police recovered pieces of the body from different places.

A murder case was filed against unidentified people on April 19. Police arrested four people, of whom three including Kakoli gave confessional statements before magistrates.

consumption, a press statement from BEOL said, adding that a certain amount of iron must be taken daily in order to maintain a healthy body.

A BSTI report released recently said samples of 52 products -- mostly everyday consumer goods including mustard oil, drinking water, vermicelli, turmeric, chili powder, curry powder, salt, ghee, flour, noodles, and biscuits -- "failed" against BSTI parameters.

Following reports in the media about it, Conscious Consumer Society, a consumers' rights organisation, filed a writ petition with the High Court, seeking its directive on the authorities concerned of the government for taking steps to seize or withdraw the 52 food products from the market. The HC on May 13 ordered the government to withdraw the 52 products from the market.

He said many commuters often face hassles and are charged extra at bus counters, and urged transport leaders to check scalping of tickets, hiking fares and hassling passengers.

The minister said many rundown buses ply the streets during Eid rush as many owners want to cash in on the huge demand for vehicles.

Termining rundown buses the "root cause of accidents", he said a combined effort from all quarters is needed to stop operation of such unfit vehicles on the highways.

He reiterated that Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina will inaugurate the second Meghna and Gumti bridges on Dhaka-Chattogram Highway and four underpasses, two flyovers and two bridges on Dhaka-Tangail Highway tomorrow.

However, if flow of traffic cannot be maintained systematically on a section of Dhaka-Mymensingh Highway (from City Gate area in the capital to Gazipur Chowrasta), vehicles may face congestion due to ongoing work of Bus Rapid Transit (BRT).

He asked the authorities to pause development work of BRT a few days before Eid and deploy more manpower to keep the area congestion-free.

As usual, goods-laden trucks will be barred from the highways three days before Eid, he said.

Contacted, Mominul Haque, Chattogram district fisheries officer, said they were conducting drives to curb the illegal practices to save broodfish.

He, however, said they had four Ansar members for the job before but even that number has dwindled.

"Currently, two Ansar members are guarding the river. We are trying to increase the number."

Mushfiqur Rahman, UNO of Fatikchhari, said, "Halda always tops our priority list. We stopped extracting sand from the river, mud from its banks and netting of broodfish."

However, the UNO could not provide any specific detail of the drives they conducted when asked for it.

Shamim Hossen, who was the UNO of Raozan and recently promoted to the post of assistant deputy commissioner of Bandarban, told The Daily Star they tried their best to stop the netting of broodfish.

"We were unable to stop it completely as it's not possible to guard the entire river round the clock. Miscreants catch the fish late at night, making it difficult for us to locate and arrest them," he added.
