The main event is set to take place on May 31, 2019 with the help of donations collected from interested

individuals.

Even though one event per year may

not seem to have a lasting impact, but the overall model of the project aims to make a difference in other ways. While people from all walks are life are encouraged to join, most of the team consists of students, the levels ranging from middle school to university. Their primary motive is to encourage the youth to get involved in activities that concern the society and teach them the dynamics of a successful community service event.

Different teams are set up and the youngest member is made the team leader. The other, more experienced members remain on the side lines to guide them through. Hence, the events not only deliver required



goods to the ones who are in need, they also help prepare the younger generation to become better informed about the needs of the society and the necessity for benevolence.

Be it through monetary contributions or one's participation to pack and distribute the meals, everyone is welcome to join the cause and partake in this great initiative. All acts of kindness, regardless of their magnitude, can contribute to creating a better society.
