Raudha's father calls PBI report a 'fantasy'

Agency claims its findings 'flawless'
her death twice, while Detective Branch and Criminal Investigation Department investigated into the death before PBI.
PBI submitted final report of the investigation on Wednesday and ruled out the allegation of murder.
The report mentioned Raudha took her own life out of despair.
Raudha, 20, was a second year student at Islami Bank Medical College in Rajshahi. She was found dead at her college dormitory room on March 29, 2017.
Raudha's father further wrote, "There is nothing new in this report. In fact, PBI did not do any such investigation. They kept the case pending for one year."
He added that PBI's Rajshahi branch head called him to their office in the name of investigation and asked him to accept the previous CID findings.
"They talk about Raudha's last few incoming calls and conversations with her boyfriend, when Raudha never wrote of killing herself. They never mentioned the heated argument with her classmate (who was accused of murder)," he wrote.
He wrote that PBI or CID could not explain the marks of strangulation on Raudha's neck and that her body was found on her bed and none saw her hanging.
Contacted, PBI investigation officer Sub-inspector Saidur Rahman rejected Mohamed Athif's claims.

Road crashes kill five

Five people were killed in road accidents in two districts yesterday, according to reports from our correspondents.
In Chattogram, helper of a pickup driver was killed under the wheel of the very vehicle in the city's Eidgaon area early yesterday.
The deceased -- Md Shakil, 18, from the city's Pahartali -- was asleep under the parked vehicle which the driver did not know, said Double Mooring Police Station Sub-Inspector Harun-uz-Zaman.
The accident took place when the driver started the truck and drove him over, the SI said.
The truck driver fled the scene, he said, adding that they seized the vehicle and sent the body to Chittagong Medical College morgue for autopsy.
In Sadarghat area of the city, a rickshaw-van puller was killed as a car hit the rickshaw-van around 12:30pm.
The deceased was identified as Md Babul, 26, from Kachua in Chandpur, said police.
He was declared dead at Chittagong Medical College Hospital, said Assistant Sub-Inspector Alauddin Talukder of CMCH Police Camp.
Police seized the microbus but the driver managed to flee, he said.
Earlier in the day, a man was killed as he was run over by a microbus in Mirsarai upazila of the district, said the police officer.
Identity of the deceased could not be known immediately, he said.
In Bagerhat, two pedestrians were killed as a bus ran them over in front of Circuit House in Dashani area of Sadar upazila.
The deceased were identified as Mona Begum, 65, from Dema village in the upazila; and Rani, 5, daughter of Ali Azam Khan from Badamtala area of the upazila, said Bagerhat Model Police Station Sub-Inspector Harun-ar-Rashid.

250 illegal structures demolished in Dhamrai

The Roads and Highways Department (RHD) in a drive yesterday knocked down over 250 illegal structures on both sides of Dhamrai-Kaliakoir road in Angoimore area of Dhamrai.

Nusrat murder case shifted to tribunal

The case filed in connection with the murder of Nusrat Jahan Rafi was transferred to Women and Children Repression Prevention Tribunal yesterday morning.
Feni Senior Judicial Magistrate Md Jakir Hossain passed the order and set June 10 for further hearing of the case, reports our local correspondent.
The next hearing will be held on the charge sheet at the tribunal, said Md Golam Jalani, inspector of the court.
All 21 arrestees, including principal of Sonagazi Islamia Senior Fazil Madrasa and 15 others who were charged with the murder, were produced before the court, sources said.
Plaintiff Abdullah Al Noman, Nusrat's brother, was also present at the court room.
Police Bureau of Investigation (PBI) on Wednesday pressed charges dropping names of five people, out of the total 21 accused in the case. They submitted an 808-page charge sheet before the court of Magistrate Jakir Hossain.
Of the 16 accused, 12 have already given confession statements before the Feni court.
PROSECUTION TO 'VEHEMENTLY OPPOSE' BAIL OF SONAGAZI OC: AG

MEDITERRANEAN BOAT CAPSIZE 2 travel agents put on remand

A Sylhet court yesterday granted remand of a travel agent and his associate in connection with human trafficking which led to the tragedy at the Mediterranean Sea on May 10 this year that left scores of Bangladeshis dead.
Sylhet's Senior Judicial Magistrate Layla Meher Banu sanctioned six days' remand for travel agent Enamul Hoque, and five days for his associate Abdur Razzak, after a brief hearing, said Shahidul Islam, inspector of Criminal Investigation Department (CID)'s Economy Crime Squad.
He said that the CID asked for ten days' remand for both accused.
Bilal Hosain, a survivor of the boat capsizing who recently returned from Tunisia, also deposited witness to the court, Shahidul said.
Enamul Hoque, 45, is the owner of New Yeahia Overseas in Sylhet city. Abdur Razzak, 34, hails from Brahmanbaria.
A rubber boat loaded with 84 illegal migrants was moving from Libya to Italy when it capsized near Tunisian coast at the Mediterranean Sea on the night of May 10, leaving 39 Bangladeshis missing.
On May 16, missing Abdul Aziz's brother Mofiz Uddin filed a case with Fenchuganj Police Station accusing Enamul, Razzak and three others along with 10-15 unnamed.

SAHED MURDER CASE Prime accused arrested

Police yesterday arrested the prime accused in the murder case of 16-year-old Sahed Ahmed, who was killed in an attack allegedly carried out by some teenagers of a rival gang in Housing Estate area of Sylhet city in February.
The arrestee is Limon Ahmed, 19, son of Taj Uddin, a resident of Rajargoli area in the city.
Sahed was a ninth grader in British Bangladesh International School and son of Abdul Khaliq, a resident of the city's Chowkidekhi.
SM Sahadat Hossain, officer-in-charge of Airport Police Station in Sylhet, said the prime accused was arrested from Bagbari area. He will be sent to jail after being produced before a Sylhet court.
On February 24, Sahed was going towards Housing Estate road around 7:30pm with a friend, when a group of teenagers attacked the two with sharp weapons.
He was taken to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital with serious stab injuries, where doctors declared him dead. His friend was also injured.
The next day, Sahed's brother Jahed Saifullah filed the case with the police station accusing 18 named and five unnamed persons. So far, police have arrested eight accused of the case including Limon.
