

## SSC SCRIPTS RECHECK 130 students' results changed

Results of 130 students who appeared at SSC examination this year under Barishal Education Board have been changed after rechecking. Anowar Ul Azim, controller of examinations at the board, said the revised results were published yesterday on their website. This year, 8,480 applied for reexamination of 15,985 answer papers. Of them, 130 students' results have changed. Fourteen students received GPA 5 and 42 examinees who failed in the exam were promoted to higher secondary level. Anowar added that board authorities have ordered actions against negligent examiners. SSC examination result was published on May 6.

# Bringing change through people's participation

Whenever Abdul Gaffar visits Bagmara upazila headquarters in Bhabaniganj, he is greeted by piles of garbage strewn all over. The 55-year-old Rajshahi farmer has never had the opportunity to raise the issue. On May 29, he got the chance when the upazila parishad (UP) organised an open budget meeting to inform residents about how authorities are earning from taxes and spending taxpayers' money. At the discussion in upazila auditorium, Gaffar learnt the parishad spent Tk 13 lakh for health and sanitation in 2018-19, and allocated Tk 15 lakh in upcoming fiscal. "Where did the money for sanitation go?" he stood up and asked. "The town stinks of garbage. He suggested for a well-managed expenditure. Like him, many Bagmara residents participated in the discussion. They alleged that the authorities were failing to generate income from some sectors and dragging on development activities, citing lack of funds. Parvez Raihan, deputy director of Rajshahi Local Government Division, said, "We're welcoming people's opinions, even if they are criticising us." People's participation in such meetings is making local government's activities transparent and helping the institutions establish good governance, he said. As per law, it's mandatory for UPs to propose

a budget 60 days before beginning of a fiscal year, after ensuring locals' participation. With support from UNDP's local governance project, the government is working in 240 unions and 16 upazilas of eight districts under eight divisions to strengthen local government's management. At the meeting, while proposing budget for 2019-20, worth Tk 25.80 crore, Upazila Nirbahi Officer Zakiul Islam said they expect a revenue of around Tk 2.10 crore. He said they would have to wait for government grants to achieve development goals. Shubhodanga UP Chairman Abdul Hakim said the upazila has some 600 government waterbodies and over 50 markets. It can increase earnings by managing these resources well. "But most are either illegally occupied or leased out at lower rates," he said. In reply, UNO Zakiul said rural scenario is changing and they cannot increase revenue from markets. For example, he said, they leased out "Mochmoil haat" at Tk 80 lakh last year, and failed to find a single bidder this year. "People are not taking their products to markets, they are selling directly from home," he said. About ponds, he said, revenue from its lease goes directly to government exchequer. In his budget speech, the UNO said the UP spent Tk 45 lakh for agriculture and irrigation sector in last fiscal and proposed Tk 50 lakh this time around. On this, Upazila Agriculture

Officer Rajibur Rahman said, "I don't know how the money was spent." He recommended a committee to monitor expenditure. Hearing about Tk 10 lakh budget for sports, Nazma Khatun, headteacher of Chanpara High School, said her students have been to national level competitions, yet none received any of the allocated amount. About Tk 8 lakh for cottage industry, local press club President Yusuf Ali said, "I'm not aware of any such industry in the upazila." For the first time, Bagmara upazila allocated Tk 10 lakh for development of small ethnic groups and Tk 5 lakh for third gender assistance. None of them attended the meeting. Locals also spoke about various needs including graveyard for the poor, box culverts, increasing social safety net facilities, dredging waterbodies, funds for disaster management and awareness, and demanded budget allocation for them. UNO Zakiul and UP Chairman Anil Kumar Sarker said they would take steps to fulfil people's demands. The constitution mandates for a self-sufficient local government, but its institutions are in fund crunch, due to various issues and influences, they said. At the end of meeting, farmer Abdul Gaffar told this correspondent, "I felt good about participating in it. Now I know how they are earning and spending money. I can hold them responsible if the expenditure doesn't happen properly."

## AMIT MUHURI MURDER

# Infighting or pre-planned?

The investigation officer (IO) of the case filed in connection with the murder of Amit Muhuri inside the Chattogram Central Jail (CCJ) is going to seek a ten-day remand before the court to interrogate the accused Ripon Nath. Ripon, an inmate, has not given any information during primary interrogation, says the officer. "I have visited the spot and have received some vital information in this connection," said IO Aziz Ahmed of Detective Branch. "I have decided to file a 10-day remand prayer with the court to interrogate Ripon on Monday," he added. Amit Muhuri, an accused in 15 cases including two murders, was killed inside the jail on Saturday, allegedly by another inmate, Ripon Nath (27). After the incident, jailor of Chattogram Central Jail, Nasir Ahmed, filed a murder case with Kotwali Police Station accusing Ripon. According to the case statement, Ripon hit Amit in the head with a brick following an altercation.

Critically injured Amit was rushed to Chattogram Medical College Hospital (CMCH) where he died around 1am on that day. Meanwhile, Amit's father Arun Muhuri claimed that it was a "pre-planned murder". He said that his son did not even know Ripon beforehand, and there was no enmity between them. "I went to Kotwali Police Station on Saturday with the intention of filing a case accusing jail officials too. But the OC did not allow it, saying that jail authority already filed a case in this connection," said Arun. "My son has been murdered, so logically I should be the plaintiff of the case," he said. Contacted, Officer-in-Charge Mohsin said Arun did not want to file a case. "He came to me with an allegation of negligence against jail officials. So, I advised him to submit the complaint to high-ups of the jail," the officer-in-charge said. Amit Muhuri was arrested on September 2, 2017 in connection with a murder case.

## Three killed in road accidents

Three people were killed in road accidents in two districts in the last two days, according to report from our Faridpur correspondent.

In Faridpur, two people were killed and two other persons injured as a bus and pickup collided head-on on Dhaka-Khulna highway in Tatultola area of Sadar upazila yesterday.

The deceased were identified as Islam Biswas, 30, son of Rowshan Ali Biswas; and another Islam Biswas, 32, son of late Abdul Rahim from Magura.

One of them was the pickup driver and the other his helper, said police.

The injured, whose identities could not be known immediately, were taken to Faridpur Medical College Hospital.

Police seized the bus and truck but the bus driver fled the scene.

In Madaripur, a youth was killed as a bus hit a motorbike he was riding on Dhaka-Barishal highway in Kornopara area of Kalkini upazila on Friday evening, said police.

The deceased -- Kamrul Mollah, 16, son of Selim Mollah from Ghuniakul area in the upazila -- was a worker of a motorbike garage.

## Body of minor found in travel bag

Police recovered the body of a boy from a travel bag in Shantirhat area of Patiya upazila in Chattogram yesterday afternoon.

The identity of the deceased could not be known at the time of filing this report.

Md Burhan Uddin, officer-in-charge (OC) of Patiya Police Station, said they recovered the body after being informed by locals.

Quoting locals, the OC said someone threw the bag on the street from a Cox's Bazar-bound bus in Shantir Hat area of Patiya around 2:30pm.

"Locals opened the bag out of curiosity and found the body inside. They could not identify the bus," he said, adding that they are continuing their search for the vehicle.

The body was sent to Chittagong Medical College morgue for autopsy.
