Bangladesh beat South Africa by 21 runs in WC opener; post their highest ever total in ODIs and the highest in the 2019 World Cup so far



Ace all-rounder Shakib Al Hasan struck an 84-ball 75 to help Bangladesh post 330 for six before picking up a crucial wicket as the Tigers registered a brilliant 21-run win against South Africa in their first ICC World Cup 2019 fixture at the Oval in London yesterday.

## 19 die on roads

16 of them killed in accidents involving human hauliers on busy highways


At least 19 people, including a child, were killed and 12 others injured in road accidents in four districts yesterday. As Eid-ul-Fitr is just a few days away, almost all the highways have heavy traffic.

Of the dead, nine were in Sirajganj, seven in Sunamganj, two in Gazipur and one was in Natore.

Meanwhile, a non-government organisation -- National Committee to Protect Shipping, Roads and Railways (NCPSRR) -- yesterday said 1,890 people were killed and 3,543 others wounded in 1,792 road accidents in the first five months of this year across the country.

In a press release, the NCPSRR said it got the figures after monitoring reports of 22 national dailies, 10 regional newspapers, and eight online news portals and news
