

THE BIG FOUR



Tajuddin Ahmad, the prime minister of wartime provisional government, placed the first national budget of independent Bangladesh. It was for 1972-73. He would discharge the role for the next two fiscal years. Of the other finance ministers, AMA Muhith and M Saifur Rahman delivered budget speech 12 times each and SAMS Kibria six times.
