## Netrakona people suffer as 21 km road in bad shape

Kalmakanda-Thakurakona road in Netrakona lies in an awful state for four years, causing immense sufferings to passengers.

As part of routine road maintenance work of Roads and Highways Department (RHD) the 21 km road is repaired every year. But locals blamed low quality materials used in the repair work for the road's present condition.

Hundreds of people in Kalmakanda upazila use the road to reach Netrakona and Mymensingh, but the dilapidated condition of the road makes their journey extremely painful.

Especially critical patients are the worst sufferers due to the bad condition of the road.

AKM Hadisuzzaman Hadi, chairman of Borokhapon Union Parishad (UP), said the carpeting of many parts of the road wore off, resulting in several potholes.

Despite the condition, people of the area are using the road as they have no alternative

to reach Netrakona town, he said.

In emergency cases, people of Kalmakanda use Durgapur-Jaria road as an alternative way to go to Mymensingh and due to this, they have to spend more time which made their journey very painful, said the chairman.

Suruj Ali Fakir, former chairman of Roypur UP, said as the road lies in a lowlying area, it gets flooded by the onrush of hill waters from across the border.

Upazila Nirbahi Officer Md Zakir Hossain said the road needs immediate repair to ease people's sufferings and he has already informed the authorities concerned about the matter.

Netrakona RHD Executive Engineer Md Didarul Alam said different parts of the road were washed away by flood in 2017. "We need Tk 21 lakh for maintenance of

the road every year but we do not get the required money from the department," said the engineer.

### BADC contract growers protest 'unfair' price of wheat seed

Contract wheat growers of Bangladesh Agriculture Development Corporation (BADC) formed a human chain at Thakurgaon Intersection in the town yesterday protesting fixing of 'unreasonably low' price for seed procurement from them. The growers are frustrated as the BADC

authorities have fixed the procurement price of wheat seed at Tk 32 per kg this year, which is Tk 3 lower than the previous year's, speakers said at a discussion after the human chain programme.

The wheat growers will have to count huge losses and they will lose interest in wheat cultivation if the decision is not revoked, they said.

the contract growers thirty per cent higher

price than the government's usual rate for procuring certified foundation wheat seeds from contract growers but this season the rule has not been followed, they said.

This year the government has fixed procurement price at Tk 28 per kg. Accordingly, the BADC should have fixed price Tk 36.40 per kg.

The growers demanded re-fixing of the price in line with the traditional system.

They warned of launching a tougher movement if the authorities fail to meet the demand. About 1800 contract growers produced

about 20,000 thousand tonnes of wheat on 5,000 hectares of land in three wheat seed cultivation zones of BADC in Thakurgaon this year and of it, 8,100 Traditionally BADC authorities give tonnes of wheat seeds has been procured by the corporation.

## Barguna AL expels dissident candidate

The district unit will also pursue permanent expulsion of the six Taltali leaders at the central committee of AL, he added. The expelled Taltali AL leaders are Moniruzzaman Mintu

-- a candidate in the June 18 election and vice-president of the upazila unit and president of Jubo League's upazila unit; Sultan Farazee, forests and environmental affairs secretary of the same unit; and Dulal Farazee, Alamgir Mia alias Alamgir Munshi, Nazir Hossain alias Kalu Patwary and Abul Kalam Sikder -- all members of the unit. The dissident candidate, Moniruzzaman, said he did

not receive any paper with regards to the expulsion order. "If they have taken such a decision, it would be wrongful and against the constitution [of the party]."

Meanwhile, the AL-nominated candidate Rejbi-Ul-Kabir Jomaddar at a press conference on Friday claimed that Moniruzzaman and his men attacked his supporters inside the party office in the upazila.

Abdul Mumin alias Abdullah, 28, of Koilardiar village under Gomostapur upazila in Chapainawabganj and Hazrat Ali alias Firoj Kabir alias Ali, 23, of Paranpur village under Niamotpur upazila in Naogaon.

The court also fined them Tk 10,000 each, in default, to suffer six months more. Additional District and Sessions Judge Shawkat Ali delivered the verdict in presence of the accused.

According to the prosecution, police arrested JMB member Rabiul from his house at Mushribhuja village on June 17, 2009.

Following his confession, police went to Ramjan's house at Kharagpur village and seized a pistol, three bullets and books on jihadi from while Ramjan fled.

Rabiul told law enforcers that some JMB men were trying to regroup in Bholahat, Shibganj and Gomostapur upazilas of the district.

SI Mizanur Rahman filed two cases against

> After receiving the six returnees from BGB, Tentulia police handed them over to their families, officer-in-charge of Tentulia Police Station Jahurul Islam said.

> Brac officials including Barrister Jenefa Khanam Jabbar, director of Brac's human rights and legal aid services programme, were present during the programme.

> Mother of a returnee, from Narail, said her daughter, now 17, went missing seven years ago when she went to attend a programme at a friend of hers at a nearby village.

#### INDIA SENDS 5 BANGLADESHI TEENS BACK

Meanwhile, at Benapole immigration check post, immigration police of India handed over five Bangladeshi teenagers -- four girls and one boy -- to Bangladesh immigration police after they served a year in an Indian jail for illegal entry, reports our correspondent in Benapole.

Critically injured Sana was rushed to the upazila health complex where doctors declared him dead.

Police arrested Ahsan Ullah, son of Dabir Uddin, in this connection, said the OC.
