The mysterious teeth, which had been stitting unidentified in museum drawers for more than 40 years, are the first evidence that highly adaptable wolfsized hyenas were in the North American Arctic, according to the paper published in the journal Open Quaternary.

The fossilised teeth belonged to Chasmaporthetes ossifragus hyenas that roamed the Arctic between 850,000 and 1.4 million years ago, researchers say.
