Schoolboy dies under truck driven by helper

Seven people killed in other accidents

A schoolboy lost his life under a truck reportedly driven by a helper in Sirajganj yesterday, reports our Pabna correspondent.

The victim -- Maruf Hossain, son of Shahadat Hossain -- was a third-grader of Pagla Boaila Government Primary School in Ullapara upazila, said police.

The accident happened on the school premises near Dhaka-Pabna highway minutes after Ariful Islam, the helper, started driving, said Dewan Kawshik Ahmed, officer-in-charge of Ullapara Police Station.

The truck hit the seven-year-old while he was walking to class around 9:15am, said head teacher Jannatul Fardous.

The OC said Ariful lost control over the vehicle when Maruf appeared in front of it all of a sudden. Eventually, the boy was run over by the truck, he said.

The head teacher said, "Trucks with materials often enter the school premises as construction of its building is going on."

A Dhaka court yesterday sentenced three drug peddlers to life imprisonment for possessing 2,300 bottles of Phensedyl in February 2005.

The convicts are Omar Faruque, Md Khokon and Md Anwar Hossain. They were also fined Tk 50,000 each, in default of which they will have to suffer one more year in jail.

Another accused Md Jamal alias Rony was given two years' rigorous imprisonment for the same offence. He will also be fined Tk 10,000, in failing he will suffer six more months in jail.

Of the convicts, Omar is still at large while three others were present at the court during yesterday's verdict. The punishment of the convict will be

effective from the day of his surrender or arrest. Judge Dr Md Akhtaruzzaman of the

A man was stabbed to death by his son-in-law, allegedly over a family feud in Hathazari of Chattogram yesterday. The deceased was Abdul Hakim, 50. Police arrested his

son-in-law Md Sujan Mia, 26, after locals beat him up and handed him over to police. The incident took place at Matia Masjid area of Hathazari

Sadar at around midnight. Officer-in-Charge (OC) Md Belal Uddin of Hathazari Police Station said Sujan and his wife Mirana Begum lived in Hakim's house. On Sunday night, the couple had an altercation and at one point Sujan scuffled with his father-in-law, the OC said,

quoting locals. Sujan stabbed Hakim with a knife, leaving him critically injured. Hakim was taken to the upazila health complex where he succumbed to his injuries.

The victim's son filed a murder case, said the OC.
