Confidence among German business leaders fell slightly in June, a regular survey showed Monday, continuing a monthslong trend analysts blame largely on global trade uncertainty.

monthly barometer fell 0.5 points, to 97.4, in line with forecasts from analysts surveyed by Factset and its lowest level since November 2014.

UK consumer spending growth in 2019 to be slowest in six years

Britain will see the slowest growth in consumer spending in 2019 in six years, piling even more pressure on retailers, EY ITEM Club forecast on Monday.

It said it expects spending to rise by 1.6 percent over last year, although that would be faster than an estimated 1.3 percent growth in the broader UK economy in 2019.

Consumer spending benefited from robust employment growth and a strong pick-up in real earnings growth in the second half of 2018 and early 2019 but the outlook was now weaker, the economic forecasting group said.

Assignment Title: Cumulative Impact Assessment Consultancy Services for Emergency Multi-Sector Rohingya Crisis Response Project (EMCRP)

The Peoples' Republic of Bangladesh has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Emergency Multi-Sector Rohingya Crisis Response Project (EMCRP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services. The consulting services ("the Services") include: (i) Plan and execute an integrated assessment of the cumulative impacts of Forcibly Displaced Myanmar National's camps in Cox's Bazar and related development in the Cox's Bazaar area, including power optimization and development scenarios, (ii) Lead the design of a framework for ongoing comanagement with public and private sector in Cox's Bazaar to address identified cumulative impacts, including collaborative environmental and social impact monitoring and management, (iii) strengthen the capacity of DRP influx area stakeholders in CIA and co-management.

Tentative duration of the assignment is 8 months and expected to commence in July 2019.

The Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:

- a. Registration /incorporation of consultants (with supporting documents);
- b. Back ground of the firm with brochure showing core activities;
- c. Experience in similar assignments (with assignment & project name, client, funding agency, consultancy cost and duration during last 10 years preferably in Project Data Sheet);
- d. Availability of professionals with appropriate skills (No CV for individual experts);
- e. Resources (Turnover) and
- f. Audited financial reports of last three years.

Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage.


