

# Govt official stabbed in Rajshahi

## Family suspects daughter's ex-husband behind attack

Masked miscreants stabbed a government officer at his house in Baksimoi village under Mohonpur upazila of Rajshahi yesterday.

The injured -- Altaf Hossain, 57, who is an officer of Department of Cooperatives at Manda upazila of Naogaon district -- was admitted to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital, said police.

His relatives rescued and took him to the upazila health complex after the attack at 2:15am. He was later shifted to RMCH, said Mostak Ahmed, officer-in-charge of Mohonpur Police Station.

Altaf's wife Jesmin Ara told this correspondent that he was at home alone that night.

Quoting her husband, Jesmin said, two masked men entered the house after he went to bed without shutting the door.

"They tried to suffocate him by covering his face with scotch tape. When he tried to save himself, one of them stabbed him," she said.

As he screamed, the attackers left him -- sensing the presence of neighbours around the house, she added.

Jesmin Ara suspects that her daughter's ex-husband -- whom she divorced three years back -- might have led the attack with the assistance of some locals.

Eight days ago, the former son-in-law threatened her daughter of killing the entire family for getting her remarried, she said.

Since her daughter got remarried months back, the man has been harassing her over phone, she said, adding that sensing danger, she took her daughter to a relative's house -- leaving Altaf alone at home.

# Road accidents kill 10

Ten people were killed in countrywide road accidents yesterday, according to reports from our correspondents.

In Dinajpur, two teenagers died as a tractor hit a motorcycle they were riding in Birganj upazila.

Maruf, 16, and Rana, 15, succumbed to their injuries on the way to Birganj Upazila Health Complex, police said quoting families.

The incident happened at Beltoli village while the two -- both ninth-graders -- were going to nearby Atrai riverbank, they said.

In another incident, Kamruzzaman Nayan, 17, was killed after a pickup hit a bicycle he was riding in Parbatipur upazila.

Police said Nayan, who passed SSC exam, was going to take admission in Shaheed Smriti Adarsha Degree College.

In Mymensingh, three people were killed as a lorry hit a truck from behind on Dhaka-Mymensingh highway in Mehrabari area of Bhaluka upazila.

Taijul Islam, 30, the lorry driver; Bablu Mia, 22, his helper; and Taher Uddin, 47, a fish trader, died on the spot, said Sub-inspector Abdus Salam deployed at Bhoradoba Highway Police Outpost.

In Narayanganj, a battery-run auto-rickshaw driver died when a bus collided with the vehicle on Demra-Narayanganj road in Siddhirganj area.

Babul Mia, 60, from Demra, was killed instantly, said Shahin Parvez, officer-in-charge of Siddhirganj Police Station.

He also said law enforcers seized the bus but the driver and helper fled.

In Chattogram, a transport worker was killed as a bus hit another bus from behind in the city's Chandgaon area.

Mohammad Yousuf, 36, from Lakshimpur, died at Chattogram Medical College Hospital (CMCH), said Assistant Sub-inspector Alauddin Talukdar at CMCH Police Outpost.

The driver that hit the bus carrying Yousuf fled the scene.

In Natore, a rickshaw-van puller died on the spot when a truck hit him from behind in Ahmedpur Bazar area of Boraigram.

The deceased -- Gofur Hossain, 55 -- was from Bagrom village in Sadar upazila, said Dilip Kumar Das, officer-in-charge of Boraigram Police Station.

In Thakurgaon, a motorcyclist was killed as his bike and a three-wheeler collided at Maraldoba village in Sadar upazila.

Saiful Islam Sumon, 35, from Krishnapur village in Dinajpur, died on the spot, said police.

# Sylhet Betar fells 143 trees without clearance

Once covered with greenery, the compound of Bangladesh Betar's Sylhet centre is now barren, as they felled 143 trees for development work without final clearance from Forest Department.

Present infrastructure of the centre in its 2.71 acre compound was built in 1978 and all trees were planted at the time or earlier.

According to Forest Product Transit Rule 2011, all trees must be marked and priced by the Forest Department and a final clearance must be issued prior to felling the trees.

Morteja Ahmed, Assistant Engineer of Betar's Sylhet centre, said, "A project worth Tk 55 crore is under progress for an auditorium construction. The trees were occupying that space."

He said, "Forest Department carried out the inspection, marking and pricing. To get final clearance, we filed an application with the department on May 28 this year, but we haven't received it."

"Contractors of Public Works Department arrived to start the work, so we had to cut the trees last month without clearance. We didn't want to delay the project," he said.

Abdul Karim Kim, General Secretary of Bangladesh Paribesh Andolon in Sylhet, said, "The government has spread its 'tree plantation campaign' through the radio but Bangladesh Betar itself is not aware of the negative impact of the sudden felling of so many trees."

Abu Bakar Siddik, Assistant Conservator of Forest in Sylhet said, "We cleared 65 trees when they applied in December 2018, but they again applied on May 28 for a total of 143 trees including the previous ones. We needed more time to clear this request as this is a huge number of trees, but they cut them down in a hurry. We will take necessary legal action soon."

# Five held over assault of youth

## Video goes viral on social media

Police in Chattogram yesterday arrested five people from Akbar Shah area, in connection with assault of a youth, the CCTV video of which went viral on social media in the port city.

Officer-in-Charge (OC) of Akbar Shah Police Station Jasim Uddin said the incident took place at Al-Hera Masjid Lane of Biswa Colony at around 5pm on Sunday when seven people beat up Md Mohsin, 25, who introduces himself as a Jubo League activist in the colony. After the incident, police arrested five youths conducting drives at different places of Akbar Shah.

The arrestees are Md Saju, 25; Md Masud, 18; Md Miraz, 20; Md belal, 20; and Md Tarek, 18, said police sources.

OC Jasim said there was a longstanding rivalry between two local groups and over the rivalry, a clash took place between followers of Mohsin and Saju a few days ago.

"Saju and his men went to the area on Sunday and beat up Mohsin indiscriminately after knocking him down on the ground," said the OC.

Soon after the incident, police detained five including Saju, after seeing a CCTV footage of the incident, added the OC.

The one-and-a-half minute footage, which spread on Facebook since yesterday morning, shows Mohsin trying to escape as seven youths swooped on him with sticks and iron bars, before leaving the spot in front of locals.

OC Jasim said Saju was seen holding a machete; police arrested him in possession of the sharp weapon after the incident.

"The victim did not lodge any case with the police station. However, police filed a case accusing Saju and others who were seen in CCTV footage, under Arms law," said the OC, adding that police are yet to talk to Mohsin, as he has gone into hiding after the incident.

Police have already identified the criminals and were trying to arrest them, the OC said.

# RCC relaunches City Hospital today

Rajshahi City Corporation (RCC) in partnership with Celltron Electro Manufacturing Services will relaunch the 25-bed City Hospital today on completion of a project to modernise and renovate the healthcare facility.

RCC Mayor AHM Khairuzzaman Liton announced it in a press conference at Nagar Bhaban yesterday.

The hospital building was used as the civil surgeon's office and urban dispensary till 2000, when the city corporation took it over and launched outdoor services naming it Sramajibi Hospital.

In 2002, the corporation established a 20-bed hospital and named it City Hospital.

The mayor said they were incurring a loss of Tk 90 lakh annually. Now, they joined hands with the medical equipment manufacturing company in a bid to avoid loss.

RCC signed an agreement with Celltron on May 6 to jointly run the hospital for three years, he added.

Modern medical equipment, doctors' chambers, five additional beds and three air-conditioned cabins were added to the hospital at a cost of Tk 2.5 crore, provided by Celltron. Under the three-year agreement, Celltron will pay Tk 50 lakh to RCC, said the mayor.

Addressing the press conference, Celltron Managing Director Sheikh Mohammad Faujul Mubin said daily rent of a bed will be Tk 300 while of a cabin, Tk 3,000.

Mayor Khairuzzaman said the hospital would provide free treatment to at least ten percent of the patients.

# 9TH WAGE BOARD Announcement likely this month: Quader

Road Transport and Bridges Minister Obaidul Quader yesterday said the announcement of the 9th Wage Board Award for journalists and employees of newspapers and news agencies could possibly happen within this month.

Quader, also chief of the cabinet committee on the issue, said this at a press conference on contemporary issues at his secretariat office.

"It would be announced soon... within a few days. There is no rationality in leaving this [issue] hanging," he said.

The committee on June 16 held a meeting with all relevant stakeholders, including representatives of the Newspaper Owners' Association of Bangladesh (Noab), journalist leaders, and employees of newspapers and news agencies over the issue. After the meeting, Quader said that the 9th Wage Board Award will be announced soon, after a meeting of the cabinet committee and once Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina gives her consent.

Speaking about university-level education, Prof Serajul said, "The case is not that university education used to be better and now it is deteriorating. Students are losing interest in education because they do not see any future in it, they don't get any confirmation of livelihood. Unemployment problem is increasing."

Presiding over the programme, DU vice-chancellor Prof Md. Akhtaruzzaman said, to overcome the obstacles in ensuring quality higher education, the university has undertaken some initiatives.

"A recommendation cell will be formed with former vice-chancellor AK Azad as head. Committee members will conduct research, evaluate it, and give recommendation for improving the quality of education," he said.

Earlier at a celebration programme in front of the administrative building, the VC declared an honorary D.Litt degree will be conferred to Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman.

Marking the founding anniversary, different buildings of the university and dormitories were decorated with colourful lights, graffiti, festoons, and balloons.

Present and former students, teachers, and staff of the university brought out a procession on the streets of DU campus and ended it at Oporajeyo Bangla sculpture.

# Parents get life term for killing daughter

A Rangpur court on Sunday sentenced a couple to life imprisonment, for killing their daughter in Badarganj upazila of Rangpur 11 years ago.

The convicts -- Ansar Ali and Sakhina Begum -- were present at the court when Rangpur District and Sessions Judge's Court Judge Hasan Tarek delivered the verdict.

According to prosecution, the parents killed Momena Begum on August 4, 2008, and buried the body on the premises of their house.
