Not only did Rohit Sharma finish the group stages as the tournament's leading run-getter, he also made World Cup history by becoming the only player to hit five centuries in a single edition. With the ball, it was a familiar face who led the way. Australia's Mitchell Starc (L), who finished as the leading-wicket taker with 26 scalps and finished as the player of the tournament in 2015, tops the wicket-takers' chart yet again. His figures of five for 26 against New Zealand is the second best so far.
