For someone playing just his second game in this edition of World Cup, India's Ravindra Jadeja never looked to be lacking in confidence as the all-rounder remained economical till rain halted their semifinal match against New Zealand at the Old Trafford in Manchester yesterday. Jadeja had put an end to a 68-run -- the highest of the day -- second-wicket stand between Kiwi batsmen Henry Nicholls and Kane Williamson when he breached through the defences of the former with a length ball at middle and leg that turned sharply to knock Nicholls' stumps out. Although that was the only wicket he scalped on the day, the 30-year-old was only hit for two boundaries and gave just 34 runs in his 10-over spell.
