RMG worker found dead in Mirpur

An RMG worker was found dead in Dhaka's Mirpur on Monday.
The deceased, Hosne Ara, 19, used to live with her elder sister and brother-in-law.
Officer-in-Charge (OC) of Shah Ali Police Station Salahuddin Mia said police came to know about the death through the neighbours.
"We recovered the body from her house at Gudaraghat area in Mirpur-1 at 10pm and sent it to Shaheed Suhrawardy Medical College morgue for autopsy," he said.
"There was a tightly knotted scarf and towel around her neck," he added. Her sister filed a murder case in this connection.
Police detained Hosne Ara's brother-in-law Jewel for interrogation.
Sub-inspector Khondaker Moniruzzaman said Hosne Ara's elder sister and brother-in-law are also readymade garment workers.
On Monday, her sister was working overtime, and Hosne Ara was alone at home. Jewel used to stay at his workplace in the evening but he came early that day, Moniruzzaman said, quoting neighbours.
They also noticed Jewel entering and leaving the house several times.
Hosne Ara's sister came at 9pm and found her dead.
Hosne Ara got married last week to one Abul Hasem, a butcher, but she and Hasem were living separately.

Barking deer rescued in Ctg

Officials of Department of Environment (DoE), Chattogram rescued a barking deer in Akbar Shah area of the city yesterday.
Muktadir Hasan, assistant director of Chattogram DoE, told The Daily Star that they rushed to the spot to rescue the deer once locals informed them.
"We found the deer injured and took it to Chattogram Zoo for treatment immediately, where we handed it over to wildlife conservation wing of the forest department," he said.
Contacted, Abu Naser Md Yeasin Nayaz, divisional officer of forest (wildlife conservation), told The Daily Star that the deer was undergoing treatment as one of its hind legs had some injuries.

researchers led by Prof Faroque said they detected detergent and three types of antibiotics in packaged milk, after testing seven samples of widely-sold pasteurised milk from five brands and three samples of unpasteurised milk. The university's pharmacy department subsequently denied any involvement with the study.

Kazi Wasi Uddin, additional secretary to the fisheries and livestock ministry, on July 9 threatened to take legal action against DU researchers if they fail to show their study published in a peer-reviewed journal.
The same researchers on Saturday announced that they found traces of four antibiotics in ten samples after conducting their second round of study.

Traffic sergeant dies after being hit by truck in Barishal

Two killed in other road accidents

A traffic police sergeant died yesterday after he was hit by a truck on Barishal-Patuakhali highway near Barishal University in Barishal Sadar upazila on Monday.



The deceased is Golam Kibria, 32, from Subidkhali in Mirzaganj upazila of Patuakhali. He was serving as a traffic sergeant of Barishal Metropolitan Police (BMP) and was on duty near the university.
Habibur Rahman Khan, deputy commissioner (headquarters) of BMP, said around 12:15pm, Kibria signalled a speeding truck to stop, but it tried to flee the scene by ignoring the signal. Then the sergeant chased the truck on his motorbike to stop it.
At that time, the truck hit him and fled the scene, he said.
Abdul Malek, duty officer of Barishal Bandar Police Station, said they later seized the truck and arrested its driver Abdul Jalil Shikdar from Nalchity area. A murder case was filed.
Nurul Islam, officer-in-charge of Kotwali Police Station, said with the help of locals and highway police, Kibria was taken to Barishal Sher-E-

locals, said Bilian was walking along the road when a Khulna-bound truck hit him. He died on the spot.
"Immediately after the accident, truck driver Jahir Khan tried to flee but locals detained and handed him over to police," the OC added.
The body was sent to Khulna Medical College Hospital for autopsy. A case is going to be filed in this connection, the OC said.
In Patuakhali, a madrasa student was killed after a motorbike hit him at Subidkhali bazar in Mirzaganj upazila on Barishal-Barguna road around 8am yesterday.
The deceased is Siam, 9, son of Mizanur Rahman of Subidkhali bazar. He was a third-grader at AL-Hera Nurani Madrasa.
The accident took place when Siam was going to his madrasa. Locals brought him to a local health complex but he died on the way, Md Masumur Rahman, OC of Mirzaganj Police Station said.
On information, police rushed to the spot and seized the motorbike but the biker managed to flee, the OC added.

hindered movement of other vehicles."
Apart from ensuring security of the port, the information of drivers and helpers are needed to create a database to implement "International Ship & Port Facility Security Code" at the port, he added.
About this, Abu Bakar Siddiq, executive president of Chattogram Prime Movers' Association, said the port authority should have introduced this process long ago, which could have averted such problems.
People from all walks of life remained stuck in traffic for hours due to the tailback, and many walked to reach their destinations.
Meanwhile, many vehicles took a detour through other roads to avoid this tailback, resulting in traffic congestion on most roads in the city.
Rakib Hasan, an employee of a factory at CEPZ, said he remained stuck in traffic for four hours and then began walking. "My employer will curtail a percentage of my salary for late attendance," he lamented.
Many school-going children were seen heading back home in despair, while an ambulance carrying patient was seen stuck in traffic too.
The situation has deteriorated further due to an ongoing development work by Chattogram City Corporation (CCC) on Dewanhat overpass.
Tariqul Ahmed, a passenger on DT road, said there was no way to avoid sufferings while commuting.
"Whatever route you take, a long traffic jam is there. All of our schedules are collapsing and the distress knows no bound," he said.
Same condition occurred on Gate No. 2 area to Bayezid Bostami Road, where traffic congestion formed due to CCC's development work.
Contacted, CCC Chief Engineer Lieutenant Colonel Mohiuddin Ahmed said the roads were battered from nine consecutive days of rain, and the work was necessary to repair those.

with Tk 344.93 crore, the PM directed the authorities concerned to incorporate sports and entertainment facilities as well as shopping mall.
The planning secretary said a project on constructing six stadiums in selected upazilas placed by the Ministry of Youth and Sports was withdrawn from the meeting since mini stadiums are being constructed at upazila levels.
The PM, however, directed the authorities concerned not to construct such upazila-level stadiums using land of schools and colleges, but rather by choosing separate places for the stadiums.
She also said these stadiums will have galleries on one side while other sides will remain open.
The four new projects approved at the meeting are: overhauling and widening of main road from Holiday Circle-Bazarghata-Larpara (bus stand) under Cox's Bazar town with Tk 258.82 crore; establishment of telecommunication network at Mirsarai Economic Zone in Chattogram with Tk 61.90 crore; irrigation development at Pabna-Natore-Sirajganj upazilas using surface water with Tk 560.53 crore; and strengthening veterinary health services to protect public health with Tk 73.26 crore.
The two revised projects are: export competitiveness for job project (1st revised) with Tk 1,012.12 crore and CHT rural development project 2nd phase (3rd revised) with Tk 224.50 crore.

Statute to open an investigation have been met.
On April 9 last year, the ICC prosecutor filed a request with the court's judges for a legal ruling on the question of jurisdiction over the alleged deportation of the Rohingya.
The prosecutor has determined that there are no substantial reasons to believe that the opening of an investigation would not serve the interests of justice, taking into account the gravity of the crimes and the interests of victims.
The office of the ICC prosecutor conducts independent and impartial preliminary examinations, investigations and prosecutions of the crime of genocide, crimes against humanity, war crimes and the crime of aggression.

and what makes it special? "Since we are Bengalis, our parents are usually overprotective and tend to pamper us. But as scouts, we learn to be self-reliant and independent," Redwanul answered.
"We always follow a chain of command. By doing so, we can learn a lot like developing discipline and following instructions to accomplish tasks swiftly," said Tasnim Sultana Nafisa, a student of Viqarunnisa Noon School and College.
"One of the major skills we learn is leadership," said Ramisa Nawar, a student of Viqarunnisa. "I can confidently say that compared to a regular student, scouts have better leadership qualities. Scouting also teaches us to be prepared for any unforeseen situation."
The number of scouts is increasing every year, according to annual scout censuses. But girl scouts are disproportionately fewer than boy scouts.
When asked about this, Ramisa said, "In Bangladesh, all women face some form of discrimination. Sometimes our parents are not comfortable with their daughters staying outside for too long, and scouting is all about being outdoors. But in my opinion, scouting is really important for girls because through this I've learned how to react and take action when something bad happens."
"Sometimes we have to stay out, and relatives and neighbours comment on this. But now my family supports me because they've seen the improvement in me. Now my mother tells everyone to be scouts," said Afsara Tasnim, a Viqarunnisa student.
Ramisa added, "The situation has improved immensely. I think if the media highlights that scouts are going to international events and positively contributing to society, girls and their parents will be drawn more to the movement. Any exposure, including word of mouth is beneficial."
Indeed, the situation is improving. The rate of girls joining scouts is much higher now. With continued achievements, one day there might just be equal number of boys and girls in scouts.
