Tk 40 LAKH BRIBERY CASE ACC asks court to show DIG Mizan arrested

The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) yesterday filed an application to show suspended Deputy Inspector General (DIG) of Police Mizanur Rahman arrested in a case filed for transaction of Tk 40 lakh as bribe.
Sheikh Mohammad Fanafilya, director of ACC and investigation officer of the case, submitted the petition with Dhaka's Senior Special Judge's Court.
Mizan is now in jail in connection with another graft case filed over acquiring wealth illegally.
Judge KM Emrul Kayesh set July 21 for hearing on the petition, and directed jail authorities to produce Mizan before it on that date.
Fanafilya filed the case against Mizan and suspended ACC director Khandaker Enamul Basir with its Dhaka district coordination office-1 under the Money Laundering Prevention Act.

Sergeant Kibria laid to eternal rest

Bans helped achieve self-sufficiency in fish production

Says State Minister Ashraf Ali Khasru

Bangladesh has made such remarkable progress in fish production in recent years, that the country is now one of the biggest fish producers in the world, State Minister for Fisheries and Livestock Ashraf Ali Khan Khasru said yesterday.
"The success of Bangladesh in fish production is now recognised. Currently, we are the first in hilsa production, third in producing fish from inland water bodies, fourth in tilapia production and fifth in aquaculture production," he said.
The state minister made the remarks at a press conference held at the Department of Fisheries in the capital. The ministry organised the event marking National Fisheries Week, to be observed till July 23.
Ashraf said the government's imposition of bans on fishing have a significant contribution to achieving success in making the country self-sufficient in fish production, although they create temporary difficulties to fishermen's livelihood.
In the 2017-18 fiscal, the country's total demand of fish was about 42,38,000 tonnes. But the production was 39 tonnes surplus, ensuring self-sufficiency for the second consecutive year, said Ashraf.
"All of these are reflections of the government's timely initiatives -- such as ban on fishing jatka [hilsa fry] and sea fish during breeding season," he added.
The government implements the ban on fishing jatka for eight months (November to June) every year. The 65-day ban on saltwater fishing is from May 20 to August 23.
Last year, Bangladesh for the first time became self-sufficient in fish, producing a total of 41,34,000 tonnes of fishes -- 84,000 tonnes more than the demand.
At the conference, the state minister said the government is very much aware of the sufferings of fishermen during the ban.
"That is why we took several initiatives so that they don't have to starve. We issued specific identity cards for them to provide food support during the ban. We also initiated several social safety net programmes for them," he said.
About observance of fisheries week, Ashraf said Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina will inaugurate the event today through giving away "National Fisheries Award 2019" at Krishibid Institution Bangladesh (KIB) auditorium in Dhaka.
Several seminars, discussions and fairs will also be held at different parts of the country on the occasion, he added.
Department of Fisheries Director General Abu Sayed Md Rashedul Haque and Bangladesh Fisheries Development Corporation Chairman Dilder were also present at the press conference.

pasteurised and unpasteurised milk.
Prof Md Abu Sayeed, president, Doctors for Health and Environment, and Gaus Piary, director, WBB Trust, among others, also spoke at the programme presided over by Abu Naser Khan, chairman of Poba.
Speakers at the programme said a quarter with vested interest is involved in producing liquid milk from sub-standard imported powdered milk.
Besides, media has often published reports that milk containing chemicals and detergent is being supplied at low cost to different companies, they added.
The DU Pharmacy Faculty and Biomedical Research Centre on June 25 revealed that its researchers found detergent and antibiotics for humans in packaged milk available in kitchen markets and grocery shops -- raising serious health concerns.
The antibiotics include levofloxacin, ciprofloxacin and azithromycin that are used mainly to treat bacterial infections in humans.
They came to the conclusion after testing seven samples of widely-sold pasteurised milk and three samples of unpasteurised milk.

by bus service company Sajan Paribahan, seeking stay on the HC judgement.
The apex court judge then sent the stay petition to its full bench for a hearing on the matter on October 13.
Sajan Paribahan's lawyer Advocate SM Shafiqul Islam Babul told The Daily Star that the HC verdict will remain in force as the SC chamber judge did not interfere in it.
Delivering verdict on a suo moto (voluntary) rule, the HC on June 20 issued some directives and observations, saying that the government should put CCTV cameras at key points on metropolitan city roads to detect reckless driving, and take action aiming at curbing road crashes and reckless driving.

BARISHAL DIVISIONAL RALLY TODAY
BNP will hold its public rally in Barishal city's Hemayet Uddin Eidgah Maidan this afternoon, reports our correspondent. Fakhru and other central, divisional and district leaders will address it.
The preparatory committee held a press conference in this regard at its party office in the city yesterday morning.
Partly leaders alleged that law enforcers and activists of Awami League are trying to foil their event by "creating panic" among BNP leaders and activists. They also alleged that pro-ruling party transport organisations are trying to disrupt vehicular movement on roads and water communications.
Among others, the press conference was addressed by Mujibur Rahman Sarwar, joint secretary general of BNP's district unit and president of Barishal city unit.
Sarwar said they are organising the rally, demanding unconditional release of Khaleda and withdrawal of "false" cases against party members. Price hike of gas and essentials, and other related issues would also be discussed, he added.
