

# No child to remain out of school: PM

UNB, Dhaka

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday said the government does not want any children to remain unschooled, as an educated nation is urgently needed to ensure a "Sonar Bangla" dreamt by Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman.

"Education is a kind of light... this light helps human being flourish. So, no child should remain outside this light and that's our aim," she said.

The PM said this while handing over awards to 12 meritorious students selected at the national

level, through "Creative Merit Searching Competition-2019" across the country at her official residence Gono Bhaban.

She said the government has formulated a policy to this end and is implementing that.

Hasina said the government is taking every programme and long-term plan after proper evaluation, so that this nation could stand on the global stage with its head high.

Mentioning that this country has a history of sacrifice, the prime minister said this nation was deprived of knowing its own real history of victory in the Liberation

A chamber judge of the Supreme Court judge yesterday upheld a High Court verdict that asked authorities concerned to conduct dope and vision tests of driving license seekers, frame rules of Road Transport Act 2018 and put them into effect in order to reduce road accidents.

Justice Md Nuruzzaman, chamber judge of the Appellate Division of the SC, passed "no order" on a petition filed

# JUDGES' SECURITY IN COURTS

## HC seeks info on steps taken

The High Court yesterday observed that judges cannot perform their functions independently and therefore, justice will not be established, if their security is not ensured in courts.

In light of the recent incident of an accused being stabbed to death by another in a Cumilla courtroom, it seems that police had negligence in ensuring security on the court premises, the HC bench of Justice

FRM Nazmul Ahasan and Justice KM Kamrul Kader said, during hearing a writ petition.

It wanted to know what steps have been taken after the July 15 incident to ensure security of judges, lawyers, officials and litigants in courts.

The HC also inquired about measures taken against those in charge of security at Cumilla Additional District and Sessions Judge's court, where the incident took place.

# BSTI should regularly conduct tests on milk: Prof Faroque

Prof ABM Faroque, director of Biomedical Research Centre, Dhaka University, yesterday called upon Bangladesh Standard and Testing Institute (BSTI), Bangladesh Food Safety Authority and Institute of Public Health to carry out regular tests on pasteurised milk from now on.

The DU professor also called upon BSTI to update its 15 year old test procedure to examine milk.

Prof Faroque came up with the call at a discussion in Dhaka Reporters' Unity.

Poribesh Bachao Andolon (Poba), WBB Trust, Doctors for Health and Environment and other non-government organisations jointly held the

programme titled "Research of DU professor on pasteurised milk: what should we do for public interest".

In his speech, Prof Faroque said BSTI, Food Safety Authority and other relevant organisations should regularly carry out tests on milk in their laboratories as antibiotics used in medical treatment have been detected in

# Madrasa students perform better than previous year

Madrasa students performed better than the previous year, as the madrasa board saw rise in the success rate and the number of GPA 5 achievers, according to results published yesterday.

The madrasa board has topped the list of 10 education boards with the pass rate of 88.56 percent. Last year, the pass rate was 78.67 percent.

A total of 2,243 madrasa students achieved highest grade point average 5, an increase by 999 compared to previous year.

A total of 86,138 students -- 48,000 male and 38,138 female -- took the Alim examinations this year.

As in HSC exams, female students fared better than their male counterparts. The pass rate of female students stands at 89.27 percent against 87.99 percent male pass rate.

Of the total 2,699 madrasas, 615 achieved 100 percent success rate, while no madrasa has zero pass rate.

Last year, 288 madrasas achieved 100 percent success rate.

## TECHNICAL EDUCATION BOARD

The pass rate of Technical Education Board rose to 82.62 percent from 75.50 percent last year. Number of GPA 5 scorers has also seen increase.

A total of 1,24,320 -- 87,864 male and 36,456
