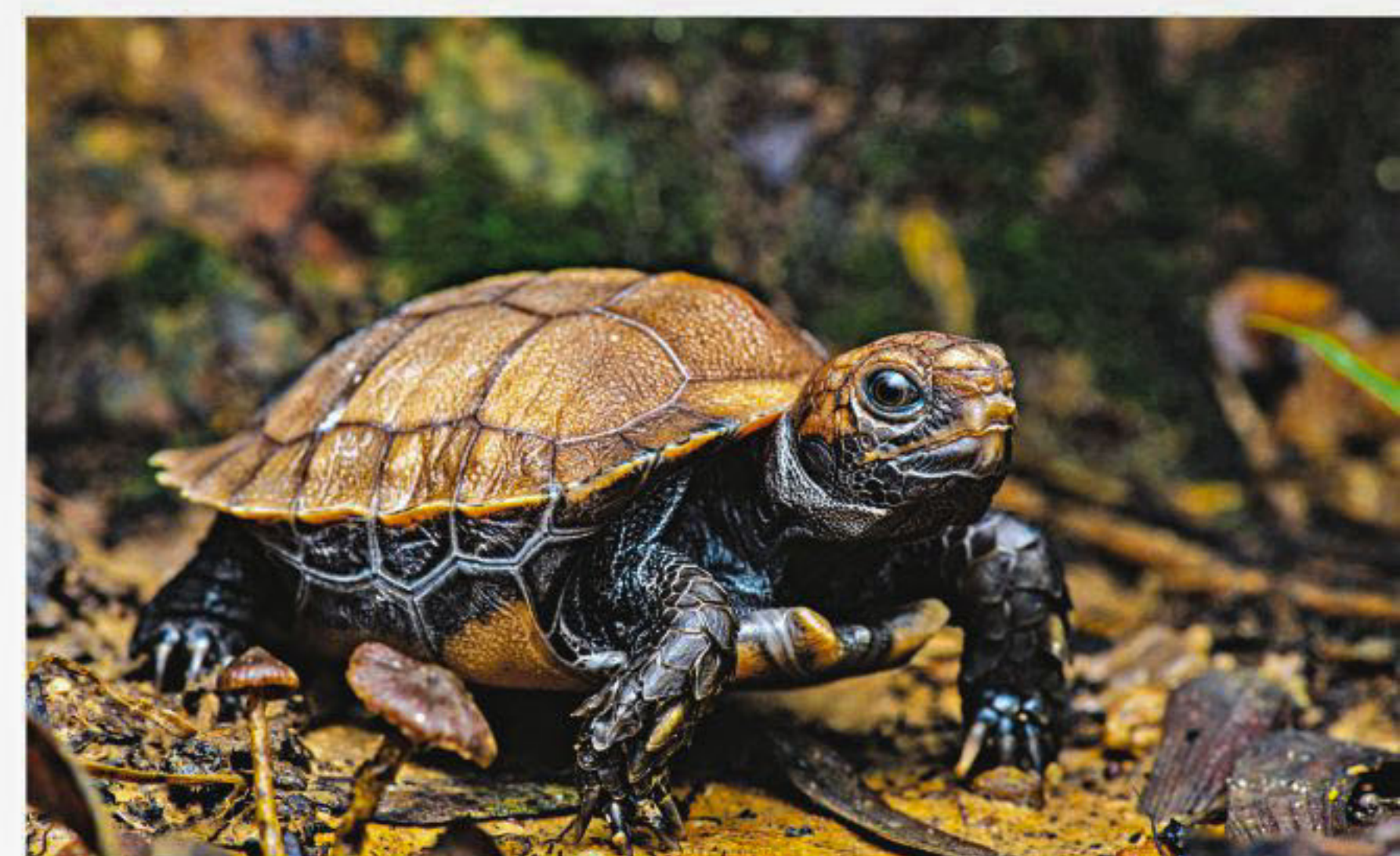




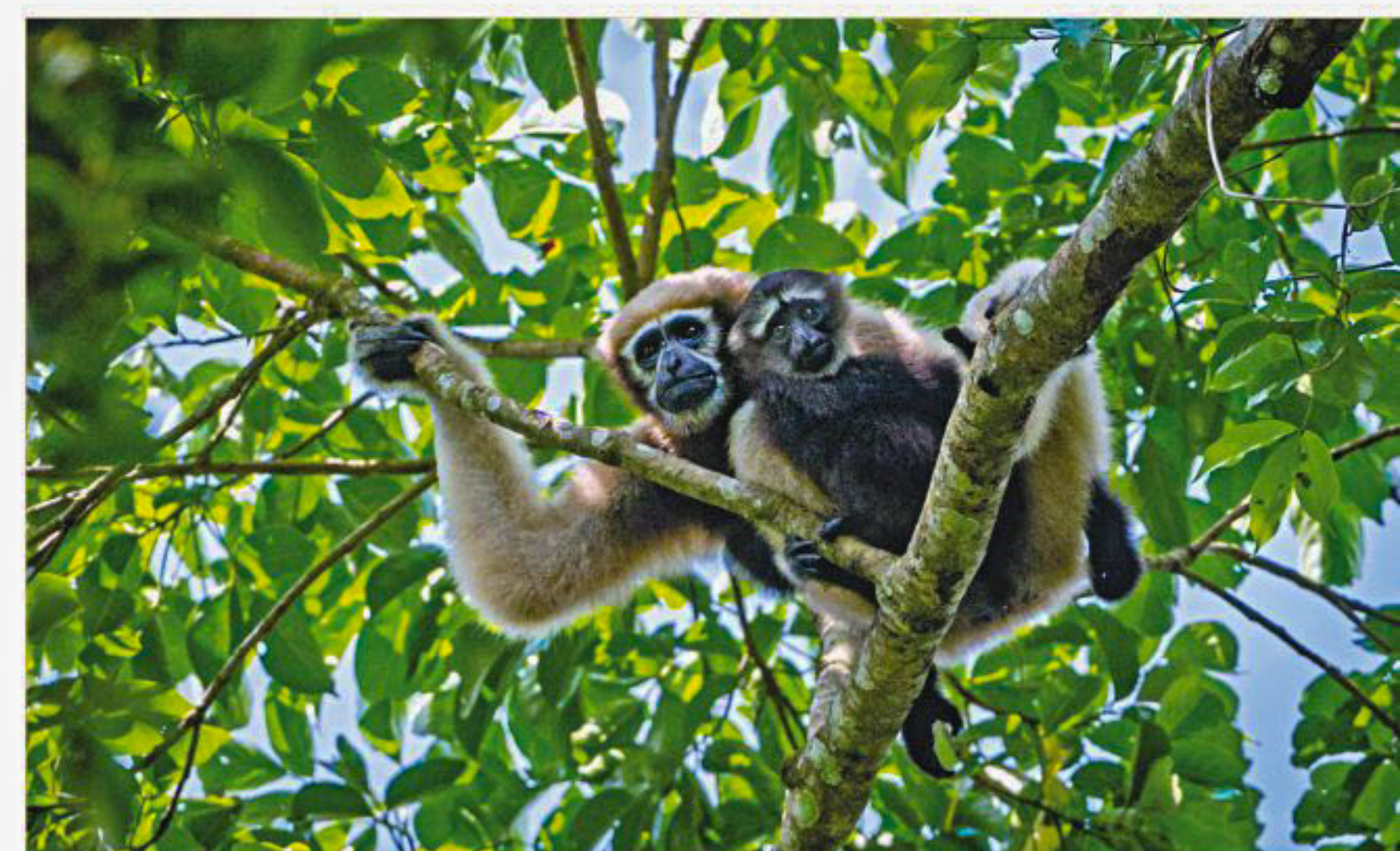
The ones you don't see

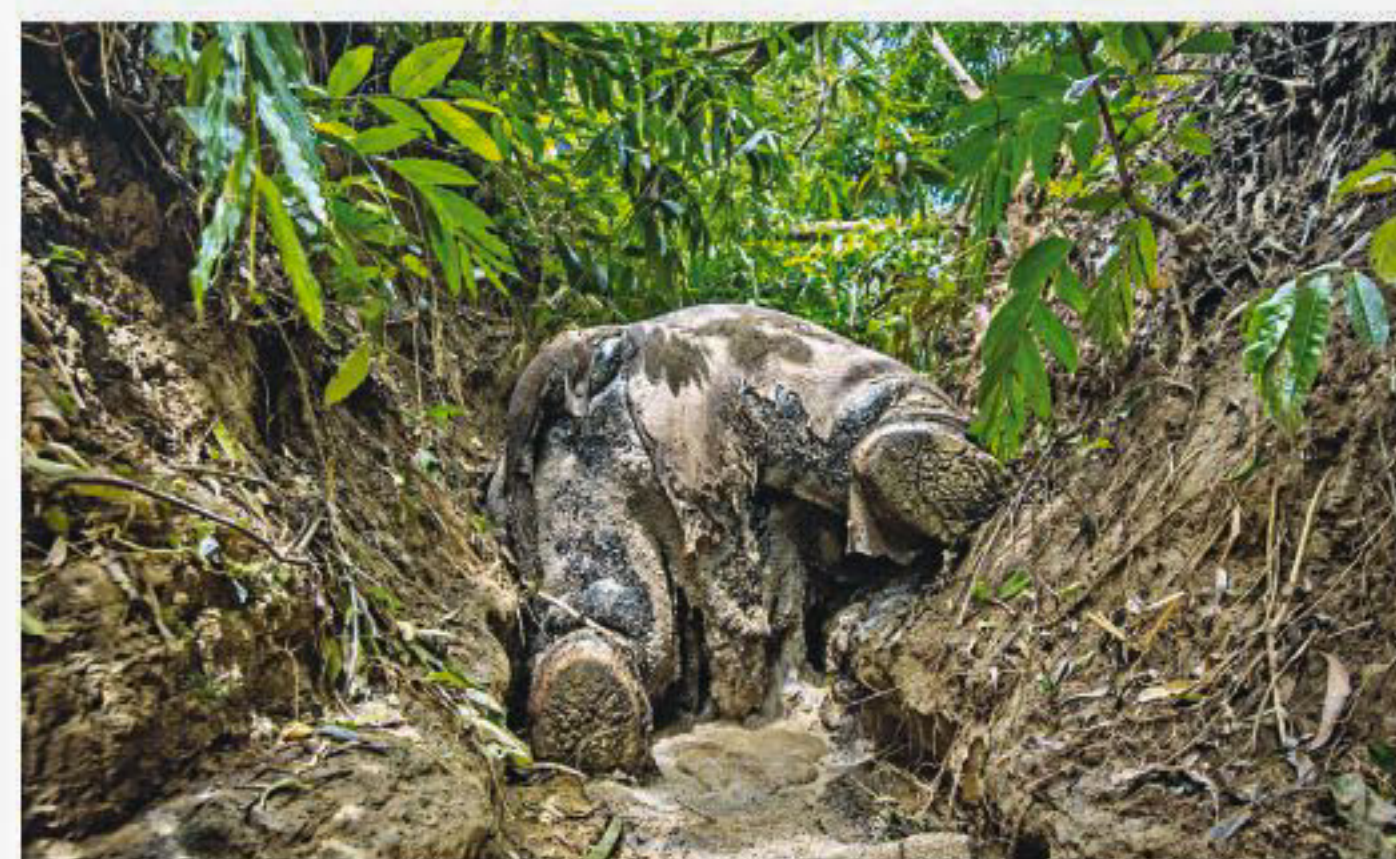
I am a Hoolock Gibbon. Lawachara is all that is left of my home. My life is spent high in the trees, but your roads still scare me.



I am a vulture. My kind has disappeared faster than any other species ever has. You know how to easily stop this, but you won't.



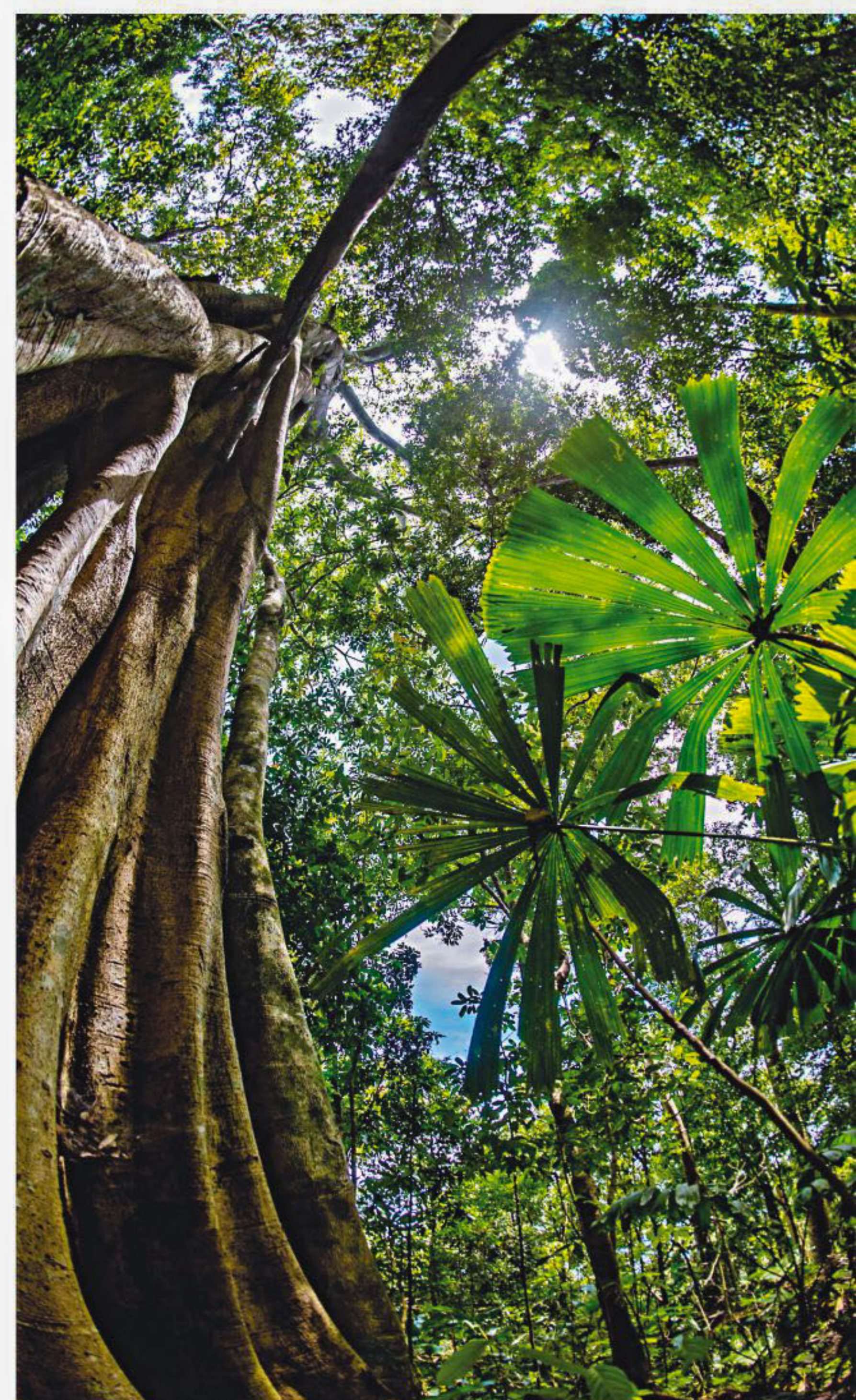
I am a harmless Vine Snake. The forests are my home, and they need me just as I need them. I did not mean to scare you.
