Actor Ryan Reynolds has joined the cast of the upcoming action-thriller, *Red Notice*. The film also stars Dwayne Johnson and Gal Gadot, and is being directed by Rawson Marshall Thurber. The film, which is set to go into production in 2020 was acquired by *Universal* last year, following a bidding war in which *Netflix* came in second. But in June, when the director, Thurber pitched the script with a higher budget, *Universal* hesitated to fund it. But, after the pitch was made to *Netflix*, the latter made an agreement with the filmmakers, and took on the project. After *Netflix* announced that they had acquired the film, *Universal* announced that an untitled film will be released on November 13, 2020, which had earlier been set as the release date of *Red Notice*.

Tupac Shakur's infamous breakup letter to Madonna is set to be auctioned off by memorabilia company, *Gotta Have Rock & Roll*. It went up for auction after the Appellate Division of the New York Supreme Court unanimously agreed to let the letter go up for auction, even though Madonna tried to stop it. The unanimous decision from the New York Supreme Court also stated that aside from this, some of Madonna's personal items, like satin underwear and a brush containing her hair will also be put up for auction. Tupac said in the letter he wrote to Madonna from prison, "But for me at least in my previous perception I felt due to my 'image' I would be letting down half of the people who made me what I thought I was." It has been reported that the opening bid for the letter will be a hundred thousand dollars, but people expect it to rise to at least two hundred or three hundred thousand.
