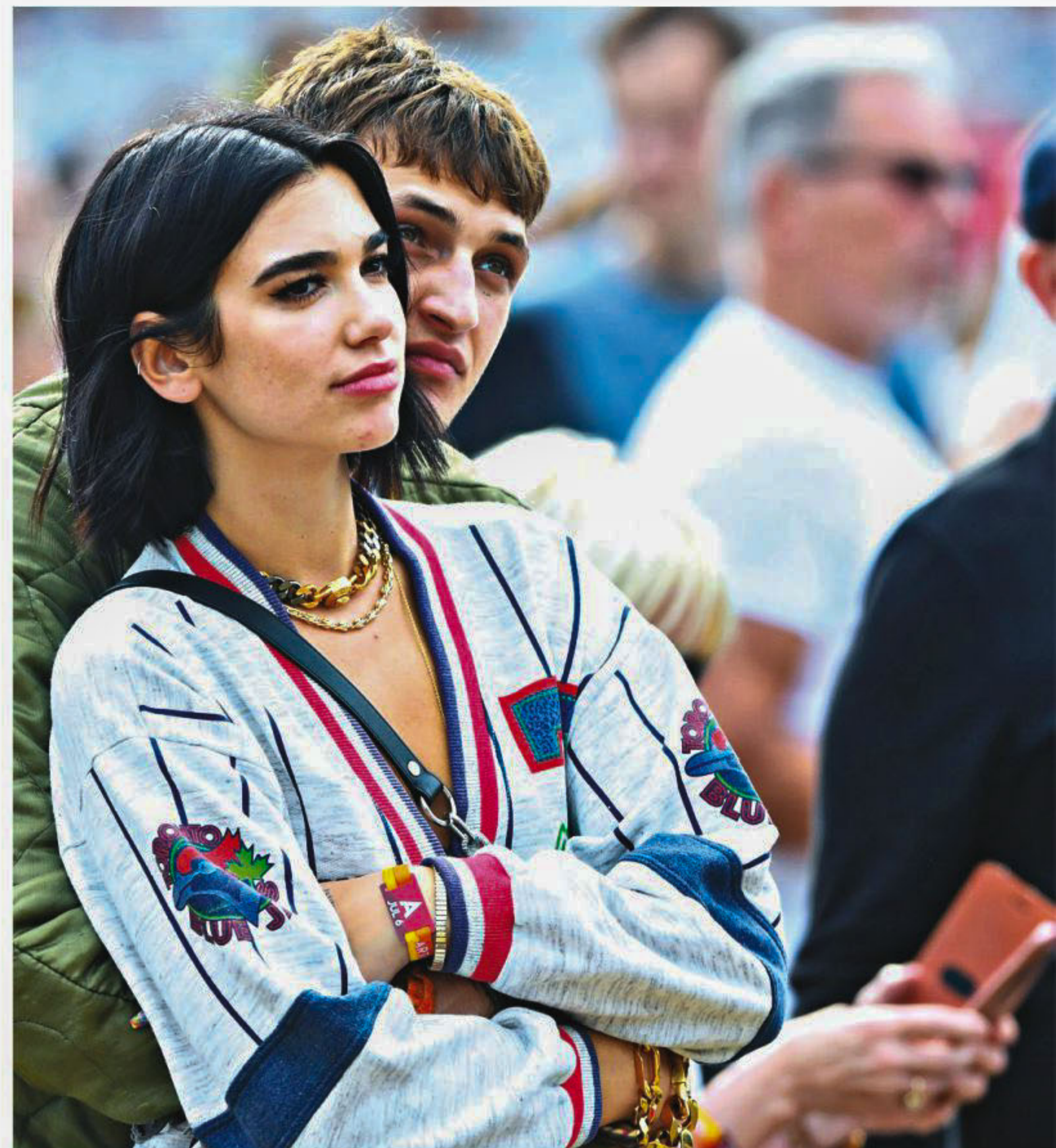


HOOKUPS & BREAKUPS
