## Poverty will reduce to 10pc before next polls: info minister

Information Minister Dr Hasan Mahmud yesterday said the country is now hunger-free and the poverty rate will reduce to 10 percent before the next parliamentary election.

"Bangabandhu's daughter Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina declared to build a hunger- and poverty-free Bangladesh... the country will be poverty-free in phases,' he said, speaking at an event at Rangunia Upazila Parishad auditorium in Chattogram.

Dr Mahmud was distributing financial assistance among 261 insolvent people from the information minister's fund. He also distributed multimedia projectors and sports items among educational institutions.

The minister said poverty rate has reduced to 20 percent from 41 percent during the last 10-year tenure of the Awami League government.

Dr Mahmud, also the publicity and publication secretary of Awami League, hoped that the rate will come down to 10 percent before the next general elections.

Once a food deficit country, Bangladesh is now a food surplus country and has decided to export food, he added. The prime minister has taken various initiatives to make Bangladesh beggar-free. The government has already

declared some upazilas beggar-free, the minister added.

He urged AL leaders and activists to remain alert against those who are only interested in "politics of votes".

#### Savar private medical college students agitate

Students of Gonoshasthaya Samaj Vittik Medical College in Savar yesterday boycotted all classes and examinations with a 10-point demand including registration under Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council (BMDC) and educational activities under Dhaka University.

Around 400 students of medicine, dentistry and physiotherapy departments of the college staged a four-hour sit-in programme and demonstrated on the campus from 10am.

They also formed a human chain and announced that they will continue the demonstration until their demands are met.

The agitating students said no medical college should be operated under a private university but their college has been operating under Gono University, a private institution.

This correspondent could not reach Prof Dr Laila Parveen Banu, acting vice-chancellor of the university, despite repeated phone calls.


