government and private hospitals in Chattogram, he said. Most of the dengue patients went to Dhaka recently, he said, adding that they suffered fever several days after they

had come from Dhaka. UNB from Bogura reports, the authorities of Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College yesterday confirmed that
