Meanwhile, defense lawyer M Khairuzzaman submitted a petition saying his client was implicated in the case falsely, adding that higher authorities had given approval to the FR Tower authorities for extension.

Earlier on Monday night, a team of ACC arrested Sadrul from Banani Rajuk quarter, for his alleged involvement with the incident.

On March 27, FR Tower in the capital's Banani caught fire, that left 25 people killed and 73 injured.

On June 25, ACC filed two cases against 23 people for their alleged involvement in illegally extending the building.

The accused include a former chairman of Rajuk, chairman of Rupayan Housing Estate Ltd, and several government officials.

The other accused are: SMHI Faruque, owner of the land on which FR Tower is built; Liakat Ali Khan Mukul, chairman of Rupayan Housing Estate Ltd, the housing company that extended the building illegally; and Tasvirul Islam, one of the owners of FR Tower.

In an ACC enquiry, it was discovered that the 23-storey FR Tower had no fire alarm, had narrow exit points or staircases, blocked fire exits and other issues.

Besides, although the authorities had permission for a 15-storey building, it was illegally turned into 23-storied.

Kamran, a nephew of the pick-up van owner, claimed he did not know anything about the drug and came to Dhaka for first time with the van.

Mahbubul Alam, an assistant commissioner of the DB North who led the drive said, they have seized around 1,100 kilogrammes of cannabises in last one year, while being smuggled into the city from India through Brahmanbaria.

"Several members of this gang are still out. We are trying to arrest them," he said.

## 42 Rohingyas sent back to Cox's Bazar from Ctg

Police sent 42 Rohingyas including women and children who fled different refugee camps, back to Cox's Bazar after detaining them from Patiya upazila of Chattogram early yesterday.

Officer-in-Charge (OC) Borhan Uddin of Patiya Police Station said they detained the 42 Rohingyas who had built shanties at Haidgao union of Patiya upazila, on Monday night after locals informed them.

During primary interrogation, the Rohingyas told police that they came to Patiya 20 days ago after fleeing from different camps in Cox's Bazar, said the OC.

After completing the legal procedures, they were sent back to their designated camps in a bus around 1am, said the OC.

## Special senate session at DU

Article 11(1) says, "The Vice-Chancellor shall be appointed by the Chancellor for a period of four years from a panel of three persons to be nominated by the Senate on such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Chancellor, and shall be eligible for re-appointment for a further period of four years."

The session will be held with a full-fledged senate almost after three decades.

On August 24, 2013, President Abdul Hamid appointed Prof AAMS Arefin Siddique as the vice-chancellor, after the latter was elected into the three-member panel.

Another VC-panel election was held on July 29, 2017 which nominated a three-member panel including the then VC Prof Arefin Siddique.

Following a writ petition filed with the High Court by 16 teachers and registered DU graduates, challenging legality of the special meeting, the Supreme Court on August 4, 2017 stayed the functions of the three-member panel.

On September 4, 2017, Prof Md Akhtaruzzaman, the then pro-VC, was made vice-chancellor, replacing Prof AAMS Arefin Siddique at the end of his tenure.

The High Court on October 10, 2017, declared illegal the three-member panel elected by the Dhaka University senate on July 29, and directed DU authorities to finish the process for constituting a

full-fledged senate in six months to elect the panel for appointing its new vice-chancellor.

Teachers have become more active in politics, centring the election.

**BLUE PANEL FINALISES SELECTION**

The pro-Awami League Blue Panel teachers already held a series of meetings to finalise their panel.

The BNP-backed White Panel teachers are yet to decide whether they would submit a panel or not.

"We have a small number of teachers as our party has been out of power for a long time. We are yet to decide on submitting panel and would take the decision considering the overall situation," Prof ABM Obaidul Islam, convener of the White Panel, told The Daily Star.

After failing to reach a consensus in their first meeting held on Sunday, Blue Panel teachers finalised their panel through election at the second meeting held yesterday, a Blue Panel teacher, seeking anonymity, told The Daily Star.

Sources said, incumbent VC, Pro-VC (administration) Prof Muhammad Samad and Dhaka University Teachers' Association President Prof ASM Maksud Kamal are likely to be in the panel.

The panel would be elected through direct votes of the senators and the panel submitted by Blue Panel would be elected uncontested if no other panel is submitted.

those who earn their living by selling milk... how will they feed their cows?"

The PM asked whether the professor (ABM Faroque) who conducted the test on milk of the 14 companies examined imported milk.

"I think he didn't do it. He should examine import, storage, packaging and marketing process of imported milk," she said.

The prime minister said Bangladesh does not want to remain dependent on imports, rather it wants to become self-reliant.

"We want to meet the demands of the country by producing all goods," she said.

"It should be examined whether there is any ploy by the importers and whether they are encouraging anyone to this end," she said.

The premier said her government is encouraging people to set up dairy farms.

"We've ensured food security; now we want to ensure nutrition," she said.

"People living in Dhaka are being affected with all four types of dengue — den-1, 2, 3 and 4. Men are more prone to it than women," he said citing their study.

He also said some patients have been affected a second time. "Of them, some one to five percent are at risk of death. But it could be avoided through proper treatment," he added.

In July, some 800 of 2,999 people who took the SN1 test were found dengue-positive.

The number of dengue-positive patients was 203 out of 491 in June.

"The percentage has reduced in this month because more people are coming for dengue SN1 tests," Munshi said.

Twenty-six out of 185 patients were tested dengue-positive in May, compared to eight out of 154 dengue-positive cases in April. The study found just one dengue-positive patient in January, February and March each.

The ratio of female to male dengue patients was found to be 1 to 2.7.
