CLASH OVER JHUT TRADE Jubo League leader among 19 sued

A case was filed against a Jubo League leader and 18 others in Ashulia early yesterday, for attacking party rebels over collecting jhut (scrap fabrics from garment factories) from an RMG factory in Narshinghopur area the night before. Police said they arrested two persons over the incident. Wife of Bazlur Rahman, a victim of the attack, filed the case against 13 named and at least 6 unnamed people with Ashulia Police Station. Kabir was made the prime accused. Bazlur, former relief and rehabilitation secretary of Ashulia unit Jubo league, is being treated at Savar Enam Medical College Hospital. "We have been conducting business with a local factory for last couple of months. Kabir and his men were trying to take over the business," he alleged. "On Tuesday night, a group led by one Sohel Mollah, an accomplice of Kabir, attacked us with rods when we were going to the factory to collect the scrap materials," he told The Daily Star at the hospital. Doctors said both of his legs were fractured. Contacted, Sohel Mollah said they had carried out the attack but did not disclose why. Kabir on the other hand denied his involvement. "I was made an accused to tarnish my reputation," claimed Kabir, convener of Yearpur union Jubo League. Rejaul Haque Dipu, officer-in-charge of Ashulia Police Station, said the case was recorded on basis of primary investigation. "We are trying to arrest the rest." Mentionable, Kabir was also made prime accused in a case filed with Kashimpur Police Station in Gazipur for beating two people over a business-related dispute on May 23.

Single-use cups, plates banned on JU campus

Jahangirnagar University authorities have banned all single-use cups and plates on campus, aiming to control spread of Aedes mosquitoes. The decision was taken by a 10-member 'Dengue Observation Cell' led by Pro-VC (admin) Prof Amir Hussain, said a press release. "We have taken elaborate plans to stop the spread of dengue at source," Prof Hussain told The Daily Star. "The first phase -- spraying insecticide on campus -- finished on Tuesday, while the second phase will start from August 19, and third phase from September 15," he added. "We will also set up awareness-raising banners and billboards on campus within August 18," he said. Earlier, authorities cancelled vacation of all cleaners and gardeners of the university to keep the premises free from mosquitoes.

A curious decision

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faced fines from Tk 40,000 to Tk 1 lakh; and the total amount of fine is around Tk 10 lakh, said an official of the organisation. A senior DNCRP official said they started the drive after learning about the anomalies in media reports. "Suddenly, we got a verbal order from the high-ups to suspend the drive, and from Sunday we haven't conducted any raid," said the official involved with the drive. DNCRP officials said the suspension order was relayed to their offices across the country over phone. On July 28, the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS) fixed dengue test fees after the High Court expressed concern over charging extra for the tests. DGHS fixed Tk 500 for dengue test, while that for Complete Blood Count test which included RBC, WBC, Platelet and Hematocrit was fixed at Tk 400 and IgM+IgG or IgM+IgE tests at Tk 500. But in some cases, medical centres were charging around few thousand takas for each test. On Saturday, DNCRP inspected two major private hospitals in the capital and fined them Tk 50,000 each for charging extra. A director of the organisation said the decision to suspend the drive came from

the commerce ministry soon after that. DNCRP is a government organisation under the ministry that conducts drives at different establishments to protect rights of consumers. Contacted, Md Mofizul Islam, senior secretary to the commerce ministry, said they have not given any directive to the directorate to suspend their drives. "But we have concerns that this inspection may hamper services at the hospitals as it is time consuming... so we have warned them not to do anything that may cause hindrance," he added. Usually when an inspection takes place, hospital authorities also become busy to facilitate the officials, leaving their duties. So, the commerce ministry asked DNCRP to keep that in mind, the senior secretary told The Daily Star yesterday. Meanwhile, officials at the ministry said a meeting was held on Tuesday presided over by the senior secretary on "Dengue and our responsibility", where he directed the DNCRP officials not to fine any hospitals and diagnostic centres. Contacted yesterday, Shameem Al Mamun, acting director general of DNCRP, said, "We have changed our strategic position and are trying to monitor the market from outside."

Port, he informed, adding that Shah Cement Factory was importer of the cement clinker and the lighter vessels also owned by the company. The accident happened around 20km off Bhasan Char. Contacted, Commander Rashedul Karim, staff officer (operation) to Commander BN Fleet, said being informed, Bangladesh Navy ship BNS Durjoy rushed to the spot and managed to rescue 10 out of 13 crew members of MV Titu-18. One crew member was rescued by the staff of a cargo vessel passing by, while two others were missing, said the Navy official. As their rescue vessel failed to reach the partly sunk MV Titu-19 due to shallow water, they sought help from Bangladesh Air Force who sent two helicopters. The choppers rescued 11 crew members from the deck of MV Titu-19.

accident and were taken to Habiganj Sadar Hospital, where Mukhles Miah succumbed to his injuries. Later, four of the injured were transferred to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College and Hospital, where Shakil died while under treatment. In Rajshahi, three people were killed when the motorcycle they were on was hit by a bus in Court Station area of the city on Tuesday, said police. Identities of the victims could not be known immediately. Two of the riders were killed on the spot. The third victim succumbed to his injuries at Rajshahi Medical College Hospital. Police seized the truck and detained its driver, they added.

Samples from clay tubs of a nursery, battery cases at a battery cell repair shop, and tyres at a vulcanising shop in Seroil area also showed positive results. At Uposhohor, the team saw positive results at four spots, including one in a plastic drum near Rangdhanu Tower, and three others in flower vases at three houses. Results of samples from five spots at Sepoypara and Rajshahi Police Lines area also came out positive. The survey report came up with four

recommendations to eliminate Aedes. It advised raising awareness on preventing stagnant water accumulation in open containers; eradication of Aedes larvae by spraying bleaching powder, kerosene, hot water or insecticide; keeping dengue-infected people inside mosquito nets. The directorate of health also warned against the spread of dengue during Eid and called upon all to follow the recommendations.
