## 5 killed in clashes over land disputes STAR REPORT

At least four people were killed in separate clashes over land disputes in Myemensingh and Sunamganj yesterday, while another was killed in a clash in Gazipur on Sunday. In Mymensingh, three

people were killed and five injured yesterday morning in an altercation over setting up a poultry farm in Ishwarganj upazila.

The dead were identified as Hashem Uddin, 70, his son Johirul Islam, 25, and his nephew Azibul Islam, 35, all from Kathaldangi village in the upazila. Quoting the victims'

## China moving troops near HK

Says Trump, urges calm as Beijing slams protest violence as 'terrorism'

China's Hong Kong Liaison office said yesterday that antigovernment protesters were no different to "terrorists" as US President Donald Trump said Chinese troops were moving to the border with Hong Kong and urged calm.

The Beijing-based Hong Kong and Macau Affairs office said extremely violent crimes must be severely punished in accordance with the law.

The strongly worded statements by China's central government follow violent clashes between black clad protesters and riot police at Hong Kong's international airport, which saw hundreds of flights halted for a second day in one of the world's busiest transit hubs. A few dozen protesters remained at the airport yesterday

while workers scrubbed it clean of blood and debris. Check-in counters reopened to queues of hundreds of weary travellers who had waited overnight for their flights. Ten weeks of increasingly violent clashes between police

and pro-democracy protesters, angered by a perceived erosion of freedoms, have plunged the Asian financial hub into its worst crisis since it reverted from British to Chinese rule in 1997. China's Hong Kong and Macau Affairs Office said it

## Kamal casts doubt over 4 more NBFIs

The financial health of four more non-bank financial institutions (NBFIs) could be bad as their funds might have been dubiously diverted, said Finance Minister AHM Mostafa Kamal yesterday.

"We suspect that funds from three to four nonbank financial institutions were not used for business purposes. We will have special audits, after which required measures would be taken," he told reporters after a meeting with managing directors and chairmen of 34 NBFIs

Asked whether the financial health of the NBFIs in question was as bad as that of People Leasing and Financial Service Ltd (PLFS), he said, "We have already taken action against People Leasing and Financial

They said the number of casualties could be higher as many accidents, especially those on regional highways and district roads, go unreported.






