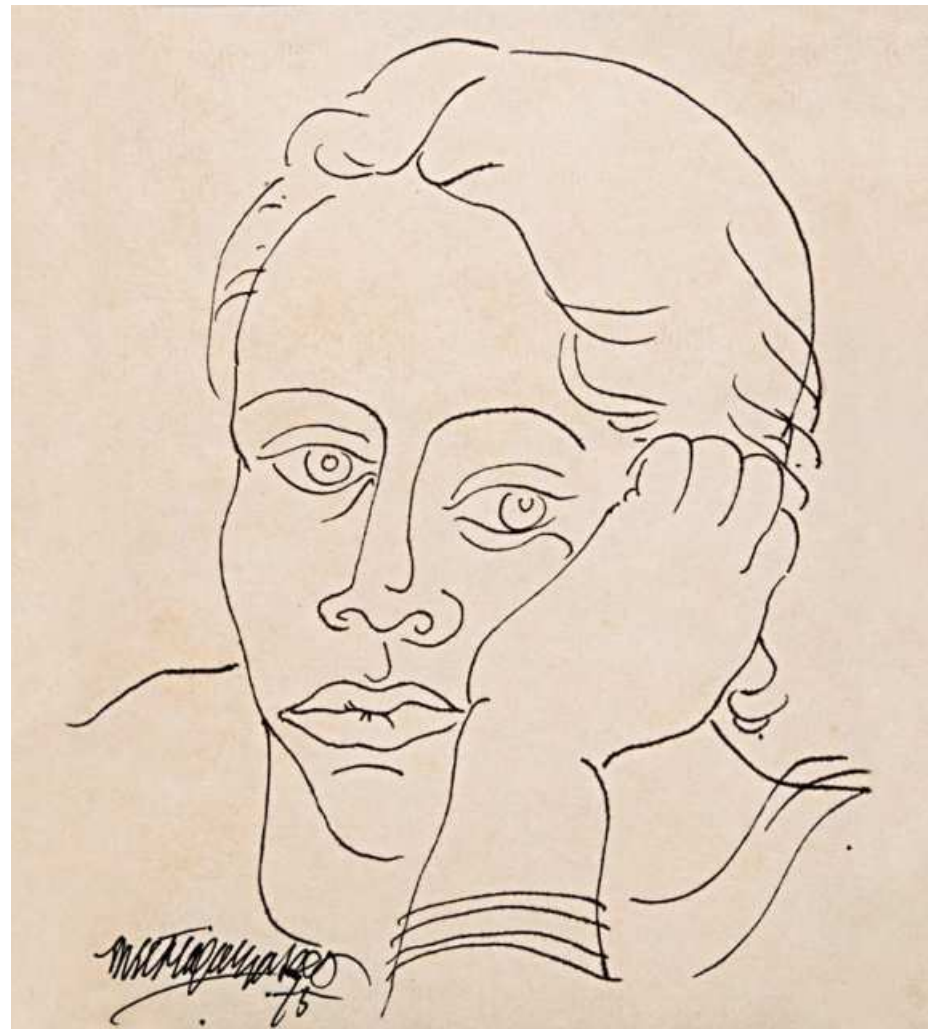
MELANIE VIOLA CANVAS PRINT
