Biman dreams big with third Dreamliner

PM inducts the new plane, Gangchil, into fleet

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday said the induction of a third Boeing 787-8 Dreamliner into the Biman fleet would enhance its capacity to operate flights to new destinations.

Referring to the newly-procured Dreamliners, she said the capacity of the national flag carrier in operating flights to long routes has grown.

The PM said this at a programme at the capital's Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport marking the commissioning of "Gangchil", reports UNB.

Hasina said her government wants Biman to operate flights on Dhaka-New York route with these aircraft.

"Now we can't operate flights to the USA, but we hope we will be able to solve the problem soon. Our Dreamliners have the capacity to fly directly to JFK airport [in New York]."

The PM said her government was making efforts to further increase the frequencies of Biman flights on Dhaka-London route.

The national carrier was also trying to introduce flights on new routes to connect more countries with a view to

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Take time-bound actions on rights

Rights alliance urges govt to follow UN recommendations

Human Rights Forum Bangladesh yesterday called upon the government to make a time-bound action plan for implementing the United Nations Committee against Torture's (CAT) recommendations for Bangladesh made at a session in Geneva recently.

To address the issue, specific pledges and their effective implementation have to come from the state's highest levels. Besides, the government has to show political commitment, said members of the forum, a platform of 20 organisations, at a press conference at Dhaka Reporters Unity.

The CAT during its 67th session, from July 22 to August 9, received Bangladesh's initial report, which was submitted after nearly 20 years, and adopted some concluding observations.

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Tiger poaching increasing

Says TRAFFIC in report; comes up with terrifying numbers; govt officials refute report

More than three tigers were poached in Bangladesh every year over the last four years, according to a report published by TRAFFIC, a UK-based international non-profit working on trade in wildlife and plants.

Although Bangladesh has only a few tigers in the Sundarbans, the trend of poaching for tiger skin, teeth, bones, skulls, and other parts of tiger body is increasing, said the report published on Wednesday.

It said 51 tigers were killed over the last 20 years and the average for 2015-18 is 3.1 tigers, which is a lot higher than that of 2000-2014 when it was 2.0.

Officials concerned in Bangladesh, however, denied TRAFFIC's claims and said poaching numbers and seizures of tiger body parts were reducing.

Mihir Kumar, conservator of



forests at the Wildlife & Nature Conservation circle of the Department of Forest, yesterday told The Daily Star, "The number of tiger skin and bone seizures

have decreased recently. We have strengthened monitoring and various conservation activities to stop poaching."

The TRAFFIC report titled "Skin and Bones Unresolved: An Analysis of Tiger seizures from 2000-2018" said a conservative estimate of 2,359 tigers were killed between 2000 and 2018 across 32 countries and territories.

There were 1,142 incidents of seizures reported, most of which were in Asia.

"Out of these, 95.1 per cent [or 1,086 incidents] occurred in the 13 Asian tiger range countries, accounting for 2,241 tigers," according to the report.

Study finds reasons for case backlog

Sloppy probe, weak prosecution key factors

Poor investigation by police, too many adjournments at courts, witness no show, poor performance by prosecutors are among leading causes for case backlogs, a study has found.

The report titled National Justice Audit Bangladesh is based on three separate surveys on judges, magistrates, police

officers, public prosecutors, defence lawyers, legal service providers, paralegals, prison and probation officers, court users and general people.

The law ministry in association with GIZ, UK Aid, and Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics conducted the surveys.

The report is based on data from 2016.
