IOCs can now export gas

Govt re-introduces the provision in its model production sharing contract for offshore gas exploration to woo int'l oil companies

International oil companies will now be able to export gas explored from Bangladesh's offshore blocks in the Bay.

The government has reintroduced the provision for export of gas by the drilling companies in the Offshore Model PSC 2019. This will not be applicable for onshore blocks.

Bangladesh has 26 blocks in the Bay. Contracts for 22 of them have not been government to backtrack on this, according awarded yet.

Besides, it has also decided to provide the international companies with more incentives like increase of gas price, exemption of tariff and mandatory drilling option in the Offshore Model PSC that the cabinet committee on economic affairs approved recently.

This time the government has framed two PSCs -- Onshore Model PSC 2019 and Offshore Model PSC 2019. The Onshore Model PSC 2019 that

governs the blocks onshore will still bar gas export and won't provide other incentives that are offered for shallow water and deep-The government had earlier included the sea blocks under the Offshore Model PSC

The ceiling price of gas has been revised up to \$215 per tonne from \$200 for offshore blocks. The floor price is \$100. For onshore blocks, the floor price has remained \$100 per tonne and the ceiling \$200, according to a government document.

Govt to utilise 'idle money'

Law on the cards for using the surplus amount for development purposes; 68 organisations now have over Tk 2 lakh crore in banks

The cabinet yesterday approved a draft law that would allow the government to use "idle funds" of state-owned organisations for development work.

There are 68 state-owned autonomous organisation which have Tk 2,12,100 crore deposited in banks,

said Cabinet Secretary Mohammad Shafiul Alam after the meeting chaired by Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina.

Among the 68 organisations, Bangladesh Petroleum Corporation (BPC) has the highest Tk 21,580 crore of idle money deposited in banks followed by Petrobangla Tk 18,204 crore, Dhaka Power Distribution

Authority Tk 13,454 crore, Chattogram Port Authority Tk 9,913 crore, and Rajuk Tk 4,030 crore.

"This money is not being used for good purposes. So, the government policy is to bring the money to the national exchequer and spend it on public welfare related activities, Shafiul said. SEE PAGE 2 COL 3

No SIM card for Rohingyas

BTRC tells mobile phone operators

To stop Rohingya refugees from using mobile phones, the BTRC and carriers yesterday decided to halt sale of SIM cards in Ukhia and Teknaf upazilas of Cox's Bazar until further notice.

They also decided to suspend 3G and 4G services in the upazilas between 5:00pm and 5:00am every day and make sure that signal from Bangladesh's carriers cannot be received from Myanmar, officials

Since there are about 8-9 lakh active SIMs in the Rohingya camp areas, the cell phone carriers were asked to check the database of national identity cards and find out to whom the SIMs were registered. The decisions came

at a meeting between cell phone carriers Bangladesh Telecommunication Regulatory Commission at the latter's office in the capital.

On Sunday, the BTRC directed all mobile phone carriers to stop selling SIMs to Rohingyas and ensure that the refugees are not provided with cell phone services.
