Joy was actually a police constable of Rajshahi Police Lines, and he was attached to the traffic police office only for Tuesday to help during a drive at Kasiadanga intersection.
Rafikul attacked the policeman with the rod and Joy tried to save himself using a helmet he was holding. He received two injuries on his head and right hand.
As other police officials came out of the office and locals shouted, Rafikul ran and escaped the spot on an auto-rickshaw, the press release says.
After arresting Rafikul, police seized the snatched helmet from his home and the rod from a drain in front of railway officers' dormitory.
A case was filed against Rafikul with Rajpara police station.

70,000 yaba pills

PROTEST OVER DISMISSAL OF 58 WORKERS Two RMG factories in Ashulia shut down

Two RMG factories were shut down for indefinite period yesterday, following an ongoing protest over dismissal of 58 workers.
Workers alleged that Eske Clothing Ltd and Naba Knit Composite Ltd in Ashulia industrial belt area sacked 28 and 30 workers respectively on August 29, without any valid reason.
They said authorities sacked the workers, mentioning not enough work at the factories. The same day, Naba Knit also banned use of mobile phones at work.
Workers have been protesting the decisions since.
Some of them also alleged that they were beaten by miscreants hired by the authorities of Eske Clothing on September 1. At least five workers, most of them women, sustained injuries.
Contacted, Adam Ali, manager (HR and compliance) of Naba Knit, said they dismissed the workers after clearing dues as per rules. "Use

of mobile phone hinders work, that's why we banned it," he added.
About the ongoing protest, he said, "We tried our best so that workers resume work but they continued to demonstrate inside the factory. In this situation, we decided to close the factory indefinitely."
Nazrul Islam, assistant general manager of Sidco group under which Eske Clothing operates, said they repeatedly asked the workers

to go back to work but to no avail. "Having no other option, we had to shut down the factory," he added.
He also said workers were sacked after clearing their dues. "We had to let them go as we did not have enough work for them."
Asked about the allegation that some workers were beaten up, Nazrul said it was not true. "While protesting, they threw a flower pot at me, which hit my forehead," he claimed.
Meanwhile, workers demanded that sacked fellows be reinstated and authorities ensure a safe environment for them.
Sarwer Hossain, a worker leader in Ashulia, hoped that authorities will accept the demands and open the factories soon. "Authorities sacked the workers without any valid reasoning. Such layoffs and shutting the factories will not solve anything," he said.
Contacted, Sana Saminur Rahman, superintendent of industrial police (Dhaka-1), told The Daily Star that the protest was hampering work environment for the past few days, although the authorities discharged the workers after paying their salaries.
"As they are yet to resolve the issue, owners shut down the factories for now," he said. Additional police have been deployed in the area, the SP said.
Some 2,000 people work in the two factories, according to officials.

port giants -- including PSA Singapore, China Merchants Sports Holding Company Limited, DP World of UAE, International Port Development Co-operation of Korea, as well as India -- have so far expressed interest in funding and constructing the mega project.
At yesterday's meeting, the port's stakeholders stressed the need for gearing up steps to implement the Bay Terminal as an extension of the port's existing yard, in order to cope with the USD 50 billion export target.
The state minister said they are working to complete the ongoing projects of the

port timely, so that it can become capable of handling the export target by 2021.
The information minister earlier at the meeting said the port's efficiency and capacity need to be enhanced, since not only the country's economic development but also the region's development depends on Chattogram port's development.
After a new minister took charge of the shipping ministry following last year's parliamentary election, the ministry on July 10 reshuffled the body of the Chattogram Port Advisory Committee, forming a 60-member new committee, comprising all stakeholders, local lawmakers and political leaders.

The US sanction on Iran is negatively affecting the trade -- not only of Iran but also of other countries having trade relations with the country, he said.
As an innovative way of addressing such problems, Zarif suggested reforms in banking system of the trading

countries.
"The most important restriction is when you use money across the border. If we use your currency in order to buy goods from you and you use our currency in order to buy goods from us, then it will be a totally different scenario. It requires banking innovation," he said.

"Bangladesh maintains that the abrogation of Article 370 by the Indian government is an internal issue of India," said the foreign affairs ministry on Bangladesh's position on the issue, according to a UNB report.
Narendra Modi's government on August 5 stripped Jammu and Kashmir of its semi-autonomy and statehood, creating two federal territories. The order revoked Article 370 of India's Constitution, which gives the state of Jammu and Kashmir its own constitution and decision-making rights for all matters except for defence, communication and foreign affairs.

care unit (ICU) later as her health condition deteriorated, said Naim Anas, executive officer of the hospital.
Reaz Ahmed, Isra's uncle, said she had been suffering from fever since August 21. She was admitted to Labaid Hospital in the capital on August 22, and later moved to the Millennium Hospital on August 25.
Reaz said Isra's father is one of the managers of Ashuganj Power Station.
Isra enrolled in Viqarunnisa School this year and lives in Azimpur along with her mother and a younger sister, he said.
Meanwhile, the pressure of dengue patients in different hospitals has started to come down, as currently 3,588 patients are undergoing treatment in hospitals across the country. Of them, 1,989 are in Dhaka.
According to the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), 820 dengue patients were admitted to hospitals across the country in 24 hours till 8am yesterday, of whom 345 were in Dhaka.
The total number of dengue patients rose to 73,565. Among them, 42,183 are in Dhaka.
