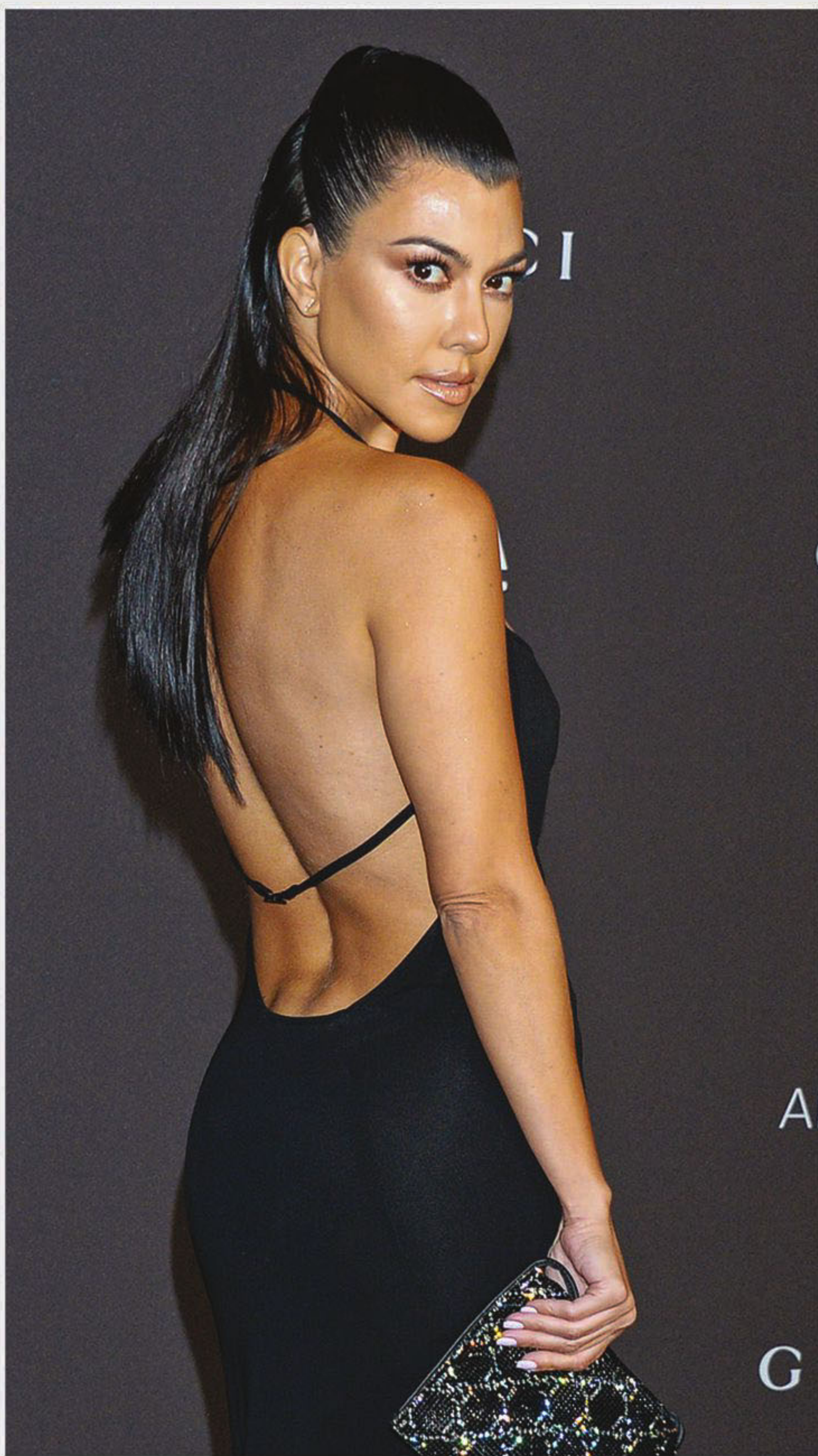




Service among the stars
