

5 police officers held with yaba

Police yesterday remanded five of its members through a Dhaka court on charges of possessing and dealing with contraband Yaba pills.

The court placed Constable Prasanta Mandal and Nayek Md Jahangir Alam of 1st Armed Police Battalion (APBn) and Assistant Sub-inspector Masud Ahmed Miaji of Gulshan Police Station on three-day remand each, says a Dhaka Metropolitan Police release.

Constable Md Roni Molla and Constable Shariful Islam of APBn were placed on two-day remand each, it said.

Around 4pm on Sunday, a team of APBn nabbed Prasanta with 552 pieces of Yaba, Shariful with Tk 15,000 drug money, and Roni for selling Yaba from an APBn barrack near Haji Camp.

After quizzing Prasanta, APBn nabbed ASI Masud and Nayek Jahangir for their involvement in drug-dealing.

A drug related case was filed against them with Uttara Purbo Police Station, the release added.

Kahlela Zia in jail, ignoring democratic values.

Mahmudur Rahman Manna, the convenor of Nagorik Oikya, said Sheikh Hasina claims she has zero tolerance for corruption and that is the reason why two top BCL leaders were removed. However, she is yet to remove many corrupt leaders from her party, he added.

"She herself should resign for becoming prime minister through vote rigging in the last election," Manna said.

Zonayed Saki, chief coordinator of Ganasamhati Andolon, blamed failure of the masses to initiate a movement for "autocratic rule" by the incumbent government.

after loan defaulters, bank looters and money launderers. We are not looking after farmers who have been counting losses," he added.

Israfil, who is a ruling party lawmaker of Naogaon-6, said that climate change has caused severe water crisis in the northwestern districts but locals are not responsible for it.

He underscored the need to revive waterbodies in northwestern districts to save local agriculture.

Lawmaker Fazle Hossain Badsha said Bangladesh is self-reliant when it comes to paddy because of bumper production of rice in northwestern districts whereas 80 percent of fish available in Dhaka come from the region.

"Northwestern districts are the crop heartland of Bangladesh. If it's destroyed due to climate change, Bangladesh will not survive with its huge population," he added.

At the event, Three women -- Costantina Hasda of Godagari upzila in Rajshahi district, Arifa Khatun of Dimla upazila in Nilphamari and Kagibala of Chilmari upazila in Kurigram -- narrated their struggles.

Hasda said temperature has changed

in Rajshahi in the last 10-15 years. People suffer from unbearable heat in summer and bone-chilling cold in winter, she added.

In summer, they face severe water shortage. "We have to collect water from at least 2-3km distance," she said.

Arifa and Kagibala are victims of river erosion.

Kagibala said she had to move at least 22 times as her homes were destroyed by river erosion. "I urge you to do something about river erosion," she pleaded.

Bangladesh Centre for Advanced Studies (BCAS) presented a study titled 'Ensure climate justice and resilient livelihoods for the poor of northwestern Bangladesh'.

While sharing their study findings, Dr Dwijen Mallick said there is disparity in regional planning and implementation of adaptation, mitigation and disaster risk reduction projects.

He said that of the allocated fund from Bangladesh Climate Change Trust, the Rangpur and Rajshahi divisions got only eight percent till February 2017, which shows a sharp regional disparity and inequality in climate fund management.

Dr Atiq Rahman, executive director, BCAS suggested giving specific attention to northwestern districts to combat climate change.

daily Prothom Alo that she had already sent two letters to registrar in this regard but was yet to get any response. Terming it their "internal issue", she refused to comment further.

This correspondent tried to contact her for the last couple of days, but she did not respond to phone calls or text messages.

Maidul alleged that some senior teachers of the department do not want to see him to attend the scholarship. "That is why they are dillydallying, to linger my leave," he said.

Contacted, CU acting vice chancellor Prof Shireen Akhter said if the planning committee of the department does not approve the leave, she had nothing to do in this regard.

Maidul Islam was sued in July last year under section 57 of the ICT Act, for making "defamatory remarks on social media against the prime minister". He was sent to jail in the case on September 24, 2018, and was freed on bail more than a month later. Last month, the High Court stayed the trial proceedings of the case.

Meanwhile, protesting the suspension order of Zinia, 22 campus journalists' associations across the country in separate statements demanded immediate withdrawal of the suspension.

They said they would otherwise stage demonstrations under the banner of Bangladesh University Journalists' Federation.

Bangladesh Chhatra Union also issued a statement yesterday, demanding removal of the VC and reversal of the suspension order of the student.

DNCC FINES BUILDING OWNERS, BUSINESSES Dhaka North City Corporation (DNCC) yesterday found Aedes mosquito larvae at 26 houses and structures, and fined some owners Tk 2.50 lakh.

Mobile courts of DNCC -- during drives to destroy Aedes breeding sources and larvae -- also found breeding sources at 5,221 houses and structures.

The courts also destroyed the breeding sources and larvae.

Councilors of all 36 wards of DNCC are supervising the drive.

A mobile court led by executive magistrate Julkar Nayon fined the owner of an under-construction building in Uttara sector-3 Tk 30,000 after finding Aedes mosquito larvae.

The court also fined the authorities of a business organisation Tk 10,000, as it found Aedes larvae on the roof of its building.

Another mobile court led by executive magistrate Sazid Anowar fined three under construction buildings of three developers and an individual in Banani Tk 50,000 each.
