Everybody now disowns Shamim

DENGUE OUTBREAK 10-day survey on to ascertain Aedes density outside Dhaka

The Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS) has launched a survey in seven districts to measure the density of Aedes mosquito there.

The 10-day survey, which began on Wednesday, will also help the DGHS give suggestions to the authorities to take necessary steps to destroy the breeding grounds of Aedes mosquito.

"Eight teams of Communicable Disease Control unit will conduct the survey in Satkhira, Barishal, Sirajganj, Rajshahi, Kushtia, Jashore and Khulna," said Prof Sanya Tahmina, line director of CDC unit at the DGHS.

She said the teams would work for 10 days, but the time would be extended, if needed. Sanya said although

dengue cases were reported in all 64 districts this year, they picked only seven for the survey due to a lack of manpower. The number of dengue

patients outside Dhaka has seen a sharp rise this year. In many cases, the disease was transmitted locally which was a matter of serious concern, said officials.

Although Aedes aegypti has been primarily associated with dengue fever, experts think that another species of Aedes mosquito might have

NID FOR ROHINGYAS

They turn their house into fake 'EC office'

Members of a syndicate were using a house in Chittagong's Hamzarbagh to make forged national identity cards for Rohingyas, police said yesterday.

Officials of Chattogram Metropolitan Police's counterterrorism unit said they raided the house in Momenbag Residential area early in the day and recovered an EC laptop and internet modems, among other devices.

Police and EC officials said the devices were being used to make dubious entries to the NID server.

Talking to the media at his office, Deputy Commissioner (counterterrorism)

Mohammed Shahidullah of the CMP said the raid was carried out based on information gleaned from Mustafa Faruk, a technical expert who lived in the house.

He said Faruk works under a temporary project of the Election Commission (EC) in Chattogram's Boalkhali. He was detained on Thursday night for his alleged involvement in the illegal syndicate.

"We came to know about Faruk's involvement in the forgery while interrogating Joynal, who has recently been arrested in a case over providing NID cards to Rohingyas," Shahidullah said, adding that two others were also held in the case filed with Kotwali Police Station on September 17.
