Tracer Study on Graduates of Tertiary-level Colleges

1. The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a credit for College Education Development Project (CEDP) from the International Development Association (IDA) Fund (Credit No.5841-BD) and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to cover eligible payments under the contract for the provision of consultancy services for the project by the following Consulting Services.
2. The objectives of the consulting services ("the Services") is to enhance policy dialogue on the labor market relevance of the college level education and their contributions to job creation in Bangladesh based on the new evidences collected by the study. It will also provide insights to inform the operations of on-going college education development project specially in providing over time information on the education quality in project supported institutions.
3. The study will produce a report which includes: (i) in-depth assessments of labor market outcomes and economic activities of graduates, current students' socio-economic backgrounds, motivation, financing agreements and perceptions on college education, market relevance of college education and training and employers' views on post-secondary education; (ii) analysis of challenges in education quality and relevance of college education; and (iii) recommendation for future policy direction for improving the quality and relevance of the tertiary college sub-sector.
4. The CEDP now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. The Consulting Firm should have at least 10 years' experience and track records on conducting the similar survey in higher education and also have a strong team to carry out the assignment. The Consultant should have experience in designing, developing and implementing at least five large surveys (sample includes more than 10,000 individuals or 5,000 Households). Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experiences to perform the Services.

A firm will be selected in accordance with the Selection Based on the Consultants' Qualifications (CQS) set out in the Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and Grants by World Bank Borrowers, 2011 (revised July 2014) and the terms and conditions mentioned in the ToR.
