Rescheduling hits a record Tk 15,469cr

Banks have rescheduled a record Tk 15,469 crore loans in the second quarter apparently to show on paper nonperforming loans have reduced.

The rescheduled loan amount for April-June quarter is 165 percent higher than that of January-March, according to the latest data from Bangladesh Bank. In the October-December quarter, loans worth Tk 12,247 crore were rescheduled, the previous record in any quarter.

What's more, many of those loans were regularised without the required down payment, usually ranging between 5 and 50 percent of the loans, central bank officials said.

More US troops in Gulf

Trump sends military reinforcements after attack on Saudi oil heartland, slaps sanctions; Iran warns against aggression

The United States has announced that it was sending military reinforcements to the Gulf region following attacks on Saudi oil facilities that it attributes to Iran, just hours after President Donald Trump ordered new sanctions on Tehran.

The developments triggered a furious response from Iran. The head of the elite Revolutionary Guards yesterday said Iran will pursue any aggressor, even it carries out a limited attack, and

seek to destroy it. "Be careful, a limited aggression will not remain limited. We will pursue any aggressor," the head of the Guards, Major General Hossein Salami, said in remarks broadcast on state TV. "We are after punishment and we will continue until the full Gulf region at the request of Saudi Arabia and the destruction of any aggressor."

On Friday, Trump said the sanctions were the toughest-ever against another country, but indicated he did not plan a military strike, calling restraint a sign of strength.

The Treasury Department renewed action against Iran's central bank after US officials said Tehran carried out weekend attacks on rival Saudi Arabia's oil infrastructure, which triggered a spike in global crude prices.

Those attacks, combined with an Iranian attack on an American spy drone in June, represented a "dramatic escalation of Iranian aggression,"

Secretary of Defense Mark Esper said. The Pentagon chief announced that the United States would send military reinforcements to the

3 more dengue patients die

Three dengue patients died outside Dhaka on Friday amid a decreasing trend of new patients' admission to hospitals. The dead are Shefali Rani, 70, of Magura, Fatema Akter, 65, of Jamalpur, and Parvin Akter, 36, of Barishal

Of them, Shefali died at Faridpur Medical College Hospital around 9:00pm on Friday.

She was admitted to the hospital around 3:00pm and diagnosed with dengue around 8:00am. She died around an hour later, said Kamoda Prosad Saha, superintendent of the hospital.

Shefali hailed from Magura Sadar upazila's Kechuadubi village, he added.

Meanwhile, Fatema died at Mymensingh Medical College Hospital.

She was admitted to the hospital on September 13 and SEE PAGE 10 COL 1

FB suspends lakhs of apps

Facebook on Friday said it suspended "tens of thousands" of apps on its platform as a result a privacy practices review launched following scandal involving Cambridge Analytica.
