Shakhawat Hossain of Chapainawabganj through an affidavit made at a Gaibandha court. Shakhawat is a second-year student of Rajshahi City Government College. Both families did not accept their marriage, police said.  
In July, Liza went to Nachole Police Station in Chapainawabganj with a similar complaint, said her friends. She said Shakhawat's parents were not letting her see him.  
Law enforcers then told Shakhawat's father to accept the union. Afterwards, they started living together, renting a place in the city's Paba area.  
Officials of Shah Makhdom Police Station corroborated the incident.  
On Saturday morning, when Shakhawat's parents once again took him away from

her, she decided to go to the police station, seeking help, said police.  
The girl's brother, who is with her at DMCH, alleged officials, while speaking to Liza, rebuked her for and refused to help. The officials of the station denied the allegations.  
"She was sent to the support centre as they [police] wanted to help in solving her problem, but she went out of the building saying that she will be back soon," said the RMP spokesperson.  
This correspondent has been trying to contact other family members, authorities of the two colleges the young couple attended, shop owners outside the police complex and locals where the couple used to live since Saturday. Some of them did pick up their phones or spoke in person but all were unwilling to comment on the issue.

this place remains the way it is now -- safe and beautiful," he added.  
The initiative is part of CDA's City Outer Ring Road project.  
CDA is almost done building a 17km embankment road from Patenga to Faujdarhat, Sitakunda. Around 5km of it will be for tourists. Due to the project, people will get access to many uncharted beach areas, Kazi Hasan Bin Shams, chief engineer of CDA, told The Daily Star recently.  
He said they divided the area into two zones. "Once completed, people from all over the country will flock here. It will be no less than Cox's Bazar," he added.  
There will be a zone for children, special facilities for the elderly, walkway and jetties as part of the project, worth Tk 500 crore, the chief engineer added. The work will end this year, he hoped.  
Contacted, Wahidul Haque, president of Patenga sea beach traders' association, said because of the development work, number of visitors has increased significantly.  
"People feel safe to visit the area, which is very important. Earlier, visitors left before evening; now some even stay till midnight," he said.  
Wahidul, however, said businesses which were evicted during the development work are yet to be rehabilitated. "We urge the authorities concerned to look into it," he added.  
Asked, the CDA chief engineer said under the project, they have dedicated a zone for vendors, where they can conduct their businesses.

Local Government Division Minister Tazul Islam said village courts are reducing pressure on the formal judicial system.  
Local Government Division Secretary Helal Uddin Ahmed said functional village courts reduce pressure on police stations and number of false cases, he added.  
Rensje Teerink, ambassador of the European Union to Bangladesh, said access to justice is a basic human right, and it contributes to democratic governance.  
Sudipto Mukherjee, Bangladesh resident representative of UNDP; and Roxana Quader, national project director of the project's second phase, also spoke at the programme.  
The Village Courts Act of 2006 provides for establishment of a court at every union parishad.  
These have jurisdiction over civil disputes valued up to Tk 75,000 as well as some crimes -- including assault and theft, although they do not have the power to fine or imprison someone. Rather, they can grant simple injunctions and award compensation up to Tk 75,000.

## Most victims still not reporting

According to BTRC statistics, the total number of active internet connections in the country now stands at 9.81 crore, which is an all-time high.  
With the growing number of internet users across the country, cyber crimes are also on the rise simultaneously. Violent extremism, rumours, political propaganda, fake news, gang culture, suicide, pornography, cyber bullying, fraudulence, extortion, and piracy are hitting the headlines regularly.  
The cyber crimes which the victims faced most are: propaganda on social media, fabrication of images online, pornography, online threats, hacking of social media accounts and fraudulence through fake IDs, according to the foundation.  
At the discussion, Bangla daily Prothom Alo's joint editor Mizanur Rahman Khan said people accuse the government for failure in various areas, like ensuring their voting rights.  
"But what we don't talk about enough is the cyber world, which is a complex and

unfamiliar area to many," Mizanur said, referring to the rising importance of cyber awareness.  
Syed Zahid Hossain, convener of Think Tank for Secure Digital Bangladesh, said culprits are committing crimes like before but the medium has changed from real to virtual life.  
Mahmuda Afroz, additional deputy commissioner (DB) of Dhaka Metropolitan Police, said they always suggest deleting secret conversations on messenger apps, as cyber criminals may hack accounts and trap the victims to extort money.  
The CCA Foundation launched the report making Cyber Awareness Month (October 2019).  
Some recommendations included in the report are: regular cyber awareness programmes, inclusion of cyber awareness in the syllabus, recruitment of honest officials, generating skilled manpower, increasing the number of trained officials in law enforcement agencies, using local technology in cyber security and government support in private initiatives.

Stressing the need for ensuring punishment of encroachers, general secretary of Bangladesh Nodi Bachao Andolon Dr Anwar Hossain said a separate river law and tribunal are very essential to bring encroachers to book.  
Mohammad Anwar Sadat, president of the platform, said Bangladesh River Commission identified 42,324 encroachers of rivers across the country, but DCs of 12 districts still did not submit their lists to the commission.  
Underscoring the need for specific dates to save the rivers from encroachers and polluters, Anwar said the number of encroachers will cross 50,000 when these 12 districts will provide encroachment lists of their districts, he said.  
Their 17-point demand include keeping effluent treatment plants of industries or factories functional round the clock, and ensuring proper treatment of human and hospital waste.  
They also demanded formulation of a comprehensive river, water and environment law, incorporating the organisations working to protect rivers, water and environment.  
Their other demands include empowering the National River Conservation Commission like Anti-Corruption Commission; reforming the water resources ministry as "River and Water Resources ministry"; forming river- and canal-recovering committees at national and local levels involving the ministry concerned, National River Conservation Commission, local administration and green organisations.  
They also demanded removal of unplanned bridges, culverts and dams and walls, and re-construction of those in a planned way after conducting necessary surveys.

Prof Muhammad Samad as chair, asking them to submit their recommendation within 10 working days.

They were later shown arrested in a case over the Gulistan IED blast that left two traffic police constables and a community policeman injured on April 29.  
On September 24, they were put on four-day remand.
