

Mystery shrouds woman's death

OC tore the paper when he went to file murder case, alleges deceased's father

Mystery has shrouded the death of Dipa Rani Roy, 20, wife of Prokash Chandra Roy of Shialkhoa village in Kaliganj upazila of Lalmonirhat.

Dipa's father Kokileshwar Roy said she was killed in a planned way by her drug addict husband on July 29.

"Meanwhile, police assisted the killer's family instead of helping us," he said.

When he went to file a murder case with Kaliganj Police Station, Sazzad Hossain, officer-in-charge (OC) of the police station, did not take the case and tore up the paper, alleged Kokileshwar.

"Instead, the OC forcibly took my signature on a paper and later an unnatural death (UD) case was filed," said Kokileshwar.

On July 29, Prokash tortured Dipa to death and he later hanged the body from the ceiling of the house to prove that she had committed suicide, alleged Kokileshwar.

On information, police recovered the hanging body from the spot the following day, he said.

Kokileshwar further said they wanted to bury Dipa after the postmortem but her in-laws cremated the body to destroy all the evidence.

Refuting the allegation of tearing the paper, the OC said a UD case was filed in this connection. Necessary action will be taken after receiving viscera report from the laboratory in Dhaka.

They interrogated two village doctors



and a relative of Dipa's husband Prokash after the incident, said the police official.

The deceased's mother Protima Rani alleged that Prokash and his associates continued threatening them.

Protima further said Prokash, 28, son of Jaduram Roy of the same village, often pressured Dipa to bring money from her father since their marriage two years ago.

Refuting the allegations, Prokash said Dipa took her own life, but he did not know the reason behind the suicide.

On August 4, local people formed a human chain on Lalmonirhat-Burimari highway in front of the police superintendent's office in the town demanding immediate arrest and exemplary punishment of the killers of Dipa.

Vermiculture brings solvency to Faridpur women

Environment-friendly vermiculture sees a growing popularity in different upazilas of Faridpur.

Around 900 people, mostly women, are now involved in making vermicompost in six upazilas of Faridpur, said Kartik Chandra Chakrabarty, deputy director (DD) of the Department of Agriculture Extension (DAE) in Faridpur.

"Four years ago, I received training from an NGO on making compost from cow dung and plants and trees leaves. There I learnt that chemical fertilisers which we use in our croplands act like poison," said Ambiya Begum, 42, wife of Khoaj

Sheikh of Chonpocha village.

"For making vermicompost, we collect plants, tree leaves and cow dung and keep in a big earthen hole. These items rot in 20 to 25 days. It is used as feed for earthworms, and finally vermicompost is made from the earthworms' dung. Now I can make 60 kg of fertiliser per month and help my family with the earning from it," she added.

Zamela Begum, 39, wife of Choken Fakir of the same village, said, "Half kg of earthworms can make around 15 kg of fertiliser per month. During the process the earthworms also increase. A kg of compost fertiliser currently sells for around Tk 10. I also sell a kg of

earthworms for Tk 4,000."

"The demand of vermicompost is high among the local farmers as it is better than chemical fertilisers. Many people offer advance payment to get vermicompost from me but I cannot meet the demand of all," said Zamela, who earns around Tk 15,000 per month by selling earthworms and natural fertiliser.

Vermicompost, very effective for soil fertility, helps crops to grow better, said Abdul Salam, 55, a farmer of Mollikpur village.

Muzahidul Islam, sub-assistant agricultural officer of Sadar upazila, said, "After starting at Chonpocha village in 2015, vermicompost

making is increasing in Kanaipur union. Many women are taking up vermiculture as it brings some extra earning for their families."


Around 30 women in five villages under Kanaipur union of Faridpur Sadar upazila are making compost with cow dung and plants, said Abul Bashar, upazila agriculture officer.

Faridpur DAE DD Kartik Chandra Chakrabarty said, "Compost fertiliser contains good amounts of key soil nutrients like nitrogen, phosphate and potash. It facilitates the production of toxin-free vegetables and crops. We provide necessary suggestions to farmers to make vermicompost."

Two jailed for raping woman, girl student

Two men were jailed for raping a woman and a teenage girl in Chapainawabganj and Jashore yesterday.

A Chapainawabganj court sentenced a man to life term imprisonment for raping a woman, reports our correspondent.

The lifer is Abu Sayam alias Shamim, 35, son of Habibur Rahman of Shibnagar village in Shibganj upazila.

Judge Shawkat Ali of Chapainawabganj Women and Children Repression Prevention Tribunal-2 also fined him Tk one lakh, in default, he is to suffer another one year in jail.

According to the prosecution, Shamim raped the 25-year-old woman of Stationpara in Rohonpur municipality area under Gomostapur upazila, alluring her with a promise of marriage on April 10 in 2013. He was later arrested.

The victim then filed a rape case with Gomostapur Police Station against Shamim.

Sub-Inspector Mamunur Rashid of the police station pressed charge sheet against Shamim on June 10 the same year.

After examining witnesses and evidence, the judge found Shamim guilty and pronounced the verdict.

In Jashore, a mobile court sentenced a teacher to one year's imprisonment for violating a female student of a mosque-based mass education centre at Sannasgachha village in Keshabpur upazila, reports our Benapole correspondent.

The convict is Abdus Sattar sheikh, a resident of the village, and a teacher of the centre.

The upazila nirbahi officer (UNO), who led the court, said Sattar raped the 13-year-old girl when she was alone in the classroom.

Man to die for killing wife

Convict Roni Ghosh was tried in absentia

A court here yesterday sentenced a man to death for killing his wife in 2013.

The convict is Roni Ghosh of Sahapara area in the town. He was tried in absentia.

Khaleda Yasmin, judge of the Women and Children Repression Prevention Tribunal in Tangail, also fined him Tk one lakh.

The judge also acquitted two other accused of the case--Roni's father Robi Ghosh and elder sister Purnima Ghosh--as charges brought against them were not proved, said Tanvir Ahmed, court inspector in Tangail.

According to the prosecution, Roni married Monti Ghosh of Nilnagar in Gazipur on June 30 in 2013.

Roni and his family members strangled Monti following an altercation over dowry on September 14 the same year.

Monti's mother Chini Ghosh then filed a murder case with Tangail Police Station.

After investigation, police later submitted charge sheet against Roni and his father and elder sister.

After examining witnesses and evidence, the judge pronounced the verdict, said Public Prosecutor AKM Nasimul Akter.
