The six rivers are the Manu, Muhuri, Khowai, Gumti, Dharla and Dudhkumar, officials said, adding that all the 54 transboundary rivers of the two countries would eventually come under the framework agreement.

Invest in Bangladesh

PM to global investors at WEF Economic Summit in New Delhi, says Bangladesh can serve as economic hub of the sub-region

UNB, New Delhi

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday urged the global particularly the investors, Indian entrepreneurs, to invest in Bangladesh's potential nonconventional areas. "It's time for global investors,

Indian particularly the entrepreneurs, to invest in Bangladesh in areas like education, light-engineering, electronics, automotive industry, artificial intelligence -- beyond the conventional menu," she said.

The PM made the call while addressing the Country Strategy Dialogue on Bangladesh at the India Economic Summit 2019 of the World Economic Forum (WEF). She was the chief guest at the programme held at Hotel Taj Palace in Delhi. She said Bangladesh deserves

the attention of global and Indian businesses as a seamless economic space between eastern and northeastern India, southeast Asian countries and China. "We can serve as the economic

hub for the sub-region. Beyond our own 162 million people, Bangladesh can be the connecting landmass to a combined market of nearly 3 billion people," Hasina

The PM said Bangladesh is moving fast to high-value, knowledge-intensive society, beyond apparel manufacturing.

Meet the owner of Uttara sector-4!

Homeowners' association decides not to allow vehicles without its sticker from next month

If you want to visit Sector-4 of the capital's Uttara by your car, from next month you will have to have your vehicle registered with a local homeowners' association by paying Tk 500 for one year.

Bizarre as it may sound, the Uttara Kalyan Samity Sector-4 is going to impose this restriction. The Samity issued a letter in this regard about 10 days

ago to all the residents, educational institutions and commercial establishments in the sector, one of a dozen in the Uttara Model Town, stirring up resentment among locals.

The September 24 letter, signed by Samity's General Secretary Kamal Hossain, reads that a vehicle has to be registered with it and obtain a sticker for Tk 500 to enter the neighbourhood. Throughout this month, all the vehicles intending

to enter Sector-4 would be subjected to checking by the society's staff, and from next month, no vehicle will be allowed in the area without the sticker, it says. To get the registration, an owner has to provide the

society with information like name and address, mobile phone number and details of vehicle, among others, according to the society's vehicle "registration form". Talking to The Daily Star, a number of residents and regular visitors said a private association does not hold any



Top-listed fugitive criminal Zeesan Ahmed of Bangladesh was arrested Wednesday night in the UAE.

"We are in correspondence with the authorities in Dubai. They informed us about the arrest," said Mohiul Islam, assistant inspector general of the Bangladesh National Central Bureau at the police headquarters.

Police are preparing documents to bring him back from Dubai, said the official of the bureau, which communicates with the Interpol.

Zeesan had an Indian passport in his possession, in which he was named Ali Akbar Choudhury, a police official said. He is on the home

ministry's list of 23 top criminals published a decade ago.

There is a reward on his head.

He was notorious in Gulshan, Banani, Badda, Motijheel and some other areas of the capital. He
