Bappy plans to visit Gulshan on Saptami. On Ashtami, he will be visiting his maternal uncle in Narsingdi. Later, he will be travelling to Comilla to see his grandfather Keshab Rai Chowdhudy on Nabami. The actor will spend the final day of Puja in his hometown, Narayanganj.

"I will be returning to the city with boxes full of sweets and love from my family after Bijoya Dashami," shared the star.




CHHAYANAUT'S SHARAT UTSHAB 2019


