

## ACC arrests one over embezzlement of Tk 2 crore

The Anti-Corruption Commission on Monday night arrested the general secretary of Rajshahi city unit of Bangabandhu Parishad, over embezzlement of Tk 2.05 crore.

Ariful Haque Kumar was arrested from his home in Sepoypara area at 9:45pm in connection with a case filed in 2018, when he was the manager of Southeast Bank in the city, said Rajshahi ACC Deputy Director Jahangir Alam.

The ACC official said Kumar was dismissed from his post two years ago. The bank authorities filed a case against him with Rajshahi sessions judge's court in March 2018 for embezzling the money.

According to the case statement, Kumar sanctioned the money as loan to one Rafiqul Islam, proprietor of Raka Enterprise, by creating false documents, and embezzled the money.

During investigation, ACC found the allegations to be true and filed a charge sheet against him, said Jahangir Alam. During trial, the court issued an arrest warrant for Kumar as he continued to ignore summons, the ACC official said.

Rafiqul, who is also an accused in the case, is on the run, he added.

## Detecting drunk drivers in 5 seconds

Ctg highway police start using breathalysers

Equipped with a new gadget that can show results in five seconds, highway police in Chattogram have started checking for drunk drivers on highways, with an aim to minimise road accidents. Officials said these alcohol-detecting devices -- known commonly as breathalysers -- were imported from China recently and distributed to every police station and outpost of highway police across the country.

Although this kind of devices have long been used in countries across the world, Bangladesh police have started using the devices only recently, including three highways of Chattogram from Sunday.

This correspondent visited Patiya Crossing of Chattogram-Cox's Bazar Highway yesterday morning where police were seen testing alcohol level in transport workers' bloodstream.

On-duty police personnel were seen asking drivers to take the mouthpiece of the tester into their mouth and blow into it. After five seconds, the result would display on the screen.

"The device can only detect alcohol and it is capable of detecting up to 100ml of alcohol consumption," inspector Bimal Chandra Bhowmik, in-charge of Patiya Highway Police Outpost told The Daily Star.

"After breathing into the mouthpiece, if the driver is drunk, the

Quoting Nafiza, Officer-in-Charge of Kotwali Police Station Md Mahmudul Islam said the woman suspected that it was a baby. She went near the drain and found a baby lying in the mud.

Seeing the baby, the woman cried out with fear and neighbours rushed to the spot to help, said the official.

## Onion prices soar again

Retailers blame high markup at Ctg wholesale outlets

Retail prices of onion from Myanmar and India have shot up by Tk 10-20 per kg in port city's kitchen markets in last one week with the excuse of high prices at wholesale hub.

A mobile court of Chattogram district administration yesterday fined two "arat" (warehouse) owners for selling onion from Myanmar at higher prices at Khatunganj wholesale market.

The team fixed wholesale prices of onion [imported from Myanmar] at Tk 50-55 per kg and Indian onion at Tk 60-65 a kg and warned the traders of stern action if they do not follow the rates.

While visiting kitchen markets in the morning and afternoon, retailers were found selling Indian onion at Tk 90-95 a kg while the price was Tk 75 last week. Retail prices of onion [Myanmar] rose to Tk 80 per kg in last few days while it was Tk 70 last week.

Mohammad Suman, a retailer at Karnaphuli CDA Market who was selling Indian onion at Tk 90 a kg, blamed higher prices at [Khatunganj] wholesale hub. He said he bought Indian onion at Tk 78 per kg from there five days ago while wholesalers

were charging Tk 84 on Monday.

Yesterday, Khatunganj wholesalers were selling Indian onion at Tk 80-85 per kg and onion from Myanmar at Tk 70-72. During the drive, Executive Magistrate Md Towhidul Islam fined M/s Azmir Bhandar and Shah Amanat Traders Tk 20,000 each for selling [Myanmar] onion at Tk 70. He said import cost of those was Tk 42 per kg.

Md Idris, a commission agent involved in selling and buying onion, said they could have lowered the prices of Indian ones two weeks back after some 500 trucks full of onion, booked before the Indian export ban, entered the country on October 4-5.

The quality of those was not good and they sold those at Tk 60-70 a kg, said Idris.

He claimed a few more previously booked onion-laden trucks have come during last couple of days but the prices are much higher and depot owners are not being able to sell those at lower prices now.

He said every day 15-20 trucks full of onion from Myanmar are arriving at Khatunganj but 40 to 50 percent of those are of bad quality. The warehouse owners are forced to sell those at Tk 25-40 a kg; so they are charging higher prices for the

## Sheikh Hasina Hall students demand removal of provost

Students of Sheikh Hasina Hall at Islamic University, Bangladesh in Kushtia staged a sit-in on Monday night, demanding removal of provost Prof Selina Nasrin from her post.

Students said the provost frequently misbehaves with them, does not pay heed to issues that students face regarding residential and food facilities of the dormitory, and shows favouritism to some.

Students also said the provost has called their guardians on multiple occasions and misbehaved with them as well. Resident students of the dormitory brought up 18 allegations in the written complaint filed to the Vice Chancellor on October 1.

VC Harun-Or-Rashid Askari assured them that steps would be taken in this regard within two months. However, since the complaint was filed, the provost became angrier and continued to misbehave with

students, said Aklima Firoja, a resident of the dormitory.

Selina also threatened students that they will lose their dorm seats, a student said.

Demonstrators said the provost had asked a student to compile a list of girls who filed the complaint. When word spread that the list was complete and would be handed over to her, a large number of students took position on the road in front of the hall, demanding removal of the provost.

The VC, treasurer, proctor and other officials came to the spot around 11:30pm. The VC asked students to return to the dorm, but students said they would only leave the spot after their demand was met. They proceeded to demonstrate until midnight.

Later, the VC said he would come up with a decision within office hours yesterday. However, no such declaration was made till filing of this report in the evening.

## Khulna rickshaw strike causes sufferings

Commuters suffered as an indefinite motorised rickshaw strike in Khulna city continued for second consecutive day yesterday.

The strike came as Khulna City Corporation continued a crackdown on banned battery-run rickshaws, said sources at KCC and rickshaw owners.

The battery-run rickshaw drivers tried to block Notunrasta intersection but police foiled the attempt. The drivers claimed that this ban will bring woes to
