Govt to protect rights of small-ethnic groups

Housing and public works minister says

With the government's stand of not allowing anyone to interfere with the rights of small ethnic communities, it (government) will not stay away from taking stern actions against the perpetrators.

This was stated by Housing and Public Works Minister SM Rezaul Karim yesterday while addressing the 'Wangala' (the 'Hundred Drums Festival') celebration programme of the Garo community in the city's Banani area.

"The daughter of Bangabandhu, Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, wants to ensure the constitutional rights of every person in this country. The present government is working in this regard. The government does not want anyone to interfere with the rights of small ethnic groups. If anyone does, the government will take stern action against him/her," he said.

The minister urged the administration to stay alert so that no ethnic groups are obstructed in practising their cultures.

The people of Garo community made immense sacrifices by participating in the War of Liberation, he said, adding that the premier will always stand by all communities to resolve their problems.

'Kathin Chibar Dan' today

'Kathin Chibar Dan', a religious festival of the Buddhist community, is being observed today across the country.

'Kathin Chibar Dan' is an annual religious festival during which Buddhists donate different items required by monks, including cloth woven in their own looms.

The ritual plays an important role in the Buddhist community -- to be a devoted follower of the religion -- through teaching them unity, solidarity and harmony.

27 punished for defying Hilsa ban in Rajbari, Shariatpur

UNB, Dhaka

At least 25 fishermen were jailed and two others were fined in Rajbari and Shariatpur for catching mother Hilsa, defying a government ban.

In Rajbari's Goalanda upazila, the local administration seized 1,00,000 metres of current net and 200 kg hilsa from 11 fishermen. A mobile court sentenced them to 14 days in jail in the early hours yesterday.

Upazila Nirbahi Officer Rubayet Hayad Shiplu said they conducted a drive in the Padma river at Daulatdia, Debagram, and Ujanchar unions between Thursday noon and early yesterday.

"The fishermen were punished for illegally catching hilsa," the UNO said.

In Shariatpur, police detained 16 fishermen in the Sadar upazila.

UNO Md Mahabubur Rahman Sheikh said 14 fishermen were sentenced to jail and two others were fined for defying the hilsa ban.

Ten maunds (roughly 373 kg) of mother hilsa were recovered from their possession, he added.

The government imposed a 22-day ban on catching, selling, storing and transporting Hilsa from October 9 to 31 to ensure safe spawning of the fish.

"People need to unite for bringing an end to this autocratic rule. We will have to spread the call for unity to all localities, districts and villages," said Dr Kamal, also president of Gonoforum.

The unity is also needed to establish rule of law and ensure people's ownership of the state, said the eminent jurist.

Jatiya Samajtantrik Dal (JSD)

President ASM Abdur Rob said the current government is doing whatever they want without caring about any rule and the country's constitution.

"It is not a people's government; it is a government of robbers," he added.

Strongly condemning the murder of BUET student Abrar, Rob criticised the decision of banning political activities on BUET campus. The Language Movement in 1952 and the

Liberation War in 1971 would not have been possible without student politics, he added.

Criticising the ruling party leaders' involvement in corruption, gambling and other illegal activities, he called upon the government to step down immediately.

JSD Vice President Tania Rob and Mukti Jot Chief Abu Layes Munna also spoke at the discussion, among others.

the abandoned animals," said her husband Rafiqul Islam. "All dogs are native species while two of the cats are foreign breeds. A relative gave them the pair as gift. Every day Sabina bathes the cats and dogs and cooks for them on her own."

As this small medicine business is their sole source of income, they have to face difficulties to meet all the expenses, Rafiqul said, adding that they, however, have no regret about the financial constraint because they chose to care for the animals.

But their love for animals often scares away friends and relatives.

"Most of our relatives and neighbours

avoid visiting our home because of the stray cats and dogs," Sabina said. "But where will they go if I don't keep them?" she asked.

"It feels bad when people speak ill of us for spending money on animal food. They often ask why I'm feeding animals instead of helping people."

What really hurts her is those people do not think about the helpless animals, Sabina said, adding that the dogs and cats would die if they are left on the streets; they have at least survived in this little shelter.

No matter what people say, her love for animals would never die, she said.
