According to a World Bank report, titled 'Bangladesh Environmental Analysis-2018', about 80,000 people in Dhaka lose their lives every year to air pollution.

Researchers have found that indoor air pollution is often between 2-5 times greater



than outdoors, and can get to extremes of up to 100 times worse than the open air. But, compared to outdoor air pollution, indoor air pollution is easily manageable, provided the indoor environment is kept

clean and free of polluting substances. Usually, the most effective way to improve indoor air quality is to eliminate individual sources of pollution, or to reduce their emissions.

Another approach is to install an air purifier. An air purifier can help you to keep your living space clean and trap airborne spores in its filters to prevent them from sticking to walls and reproducing. The air purifiers can work quickly to help remove airborne particles from the air without allowing them to reenter the room and relieve allergies quickly.
